
eManifest will modernize and enhance how the CBSA processes and screens commercial goods coming into Canada by improving the CBSA's ability to detect shipments that pose a high or unknown risk prior to their arrival through:

- Electronic pre-arrival data requirements for highway and rail carriers, freight forwarders and importers in all modes;
- Automated risk assessment of all data in advance of arrival at the border, allowing Targeters and Border Services Officers more informed decisions on whether to examine goods; and
- Business Intelligence using operational feedback (exam results, targeter comments on risk indicators) along with historical trend analysis to monitor and improve risk assessment methodologies (risk indicator effectiveness, risk scoring).


