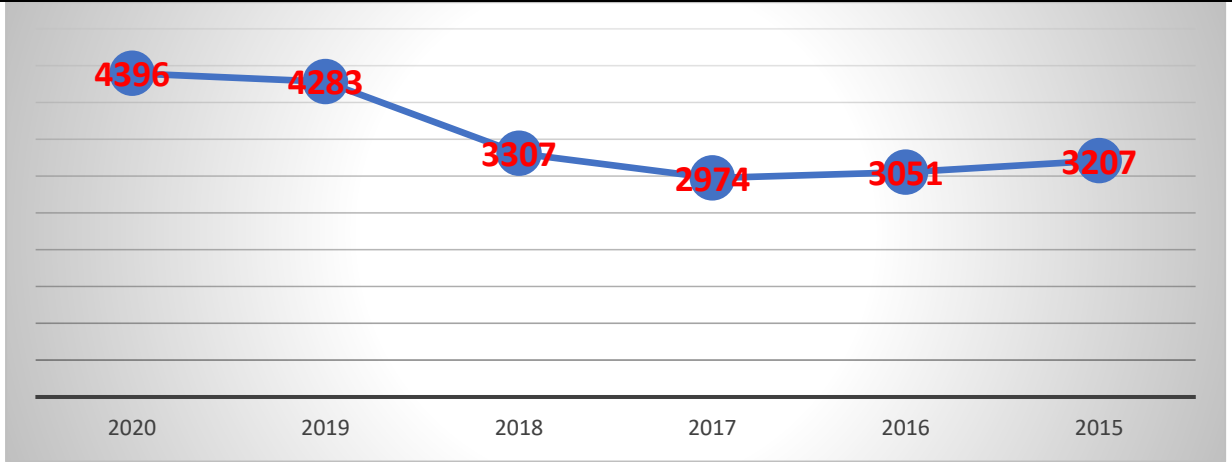


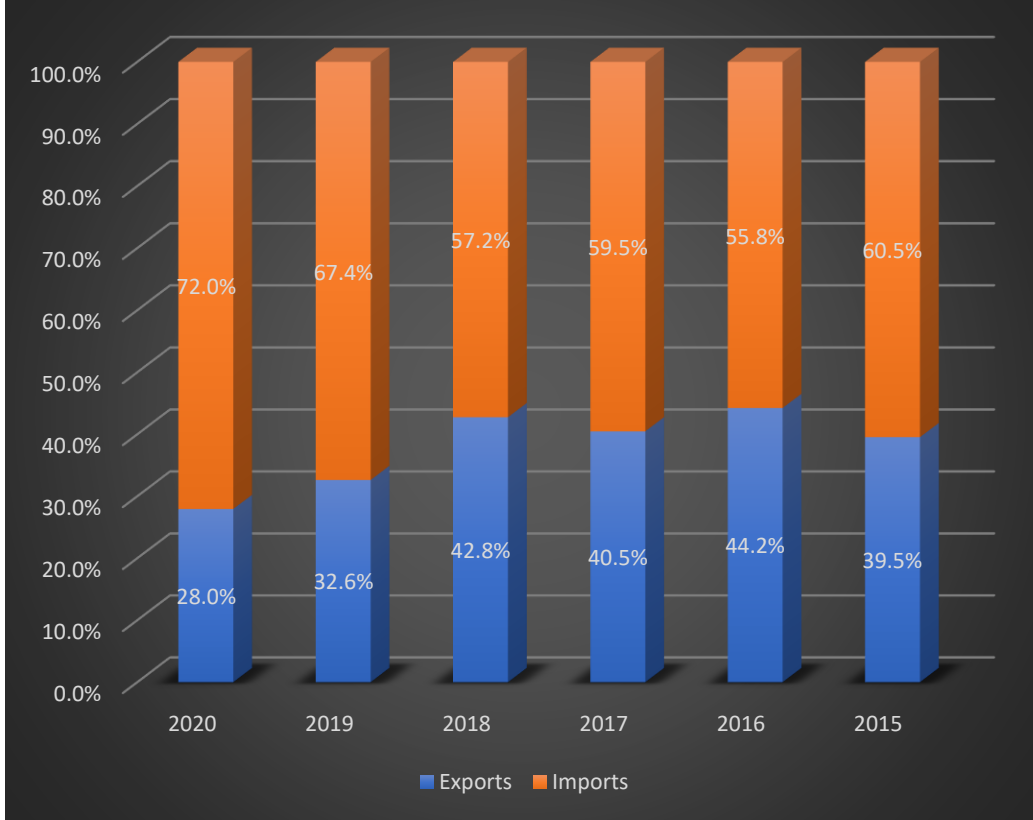
MAINE: CANADA – U.S. TRADE (US\$)

1. Total Maine – Canada Trade – Exports and Imports

In 2020, total Maine - Canada trade increased by \$113 Million from \$4.3 billion in 2019, to \$4.4 billion in 2020. This change was comprised of a \$170 million decline in exports and a \$280 million increase in imports.



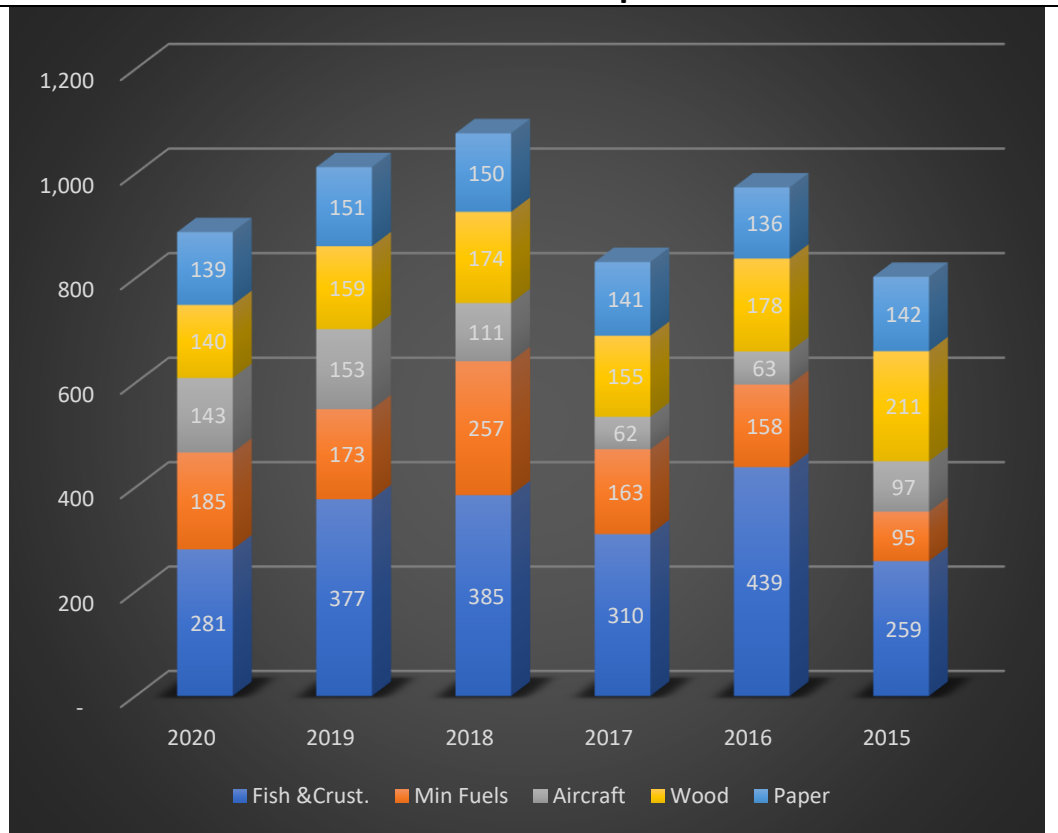
2. Total Maine – Canada Trade – Shares of Exports and Imports



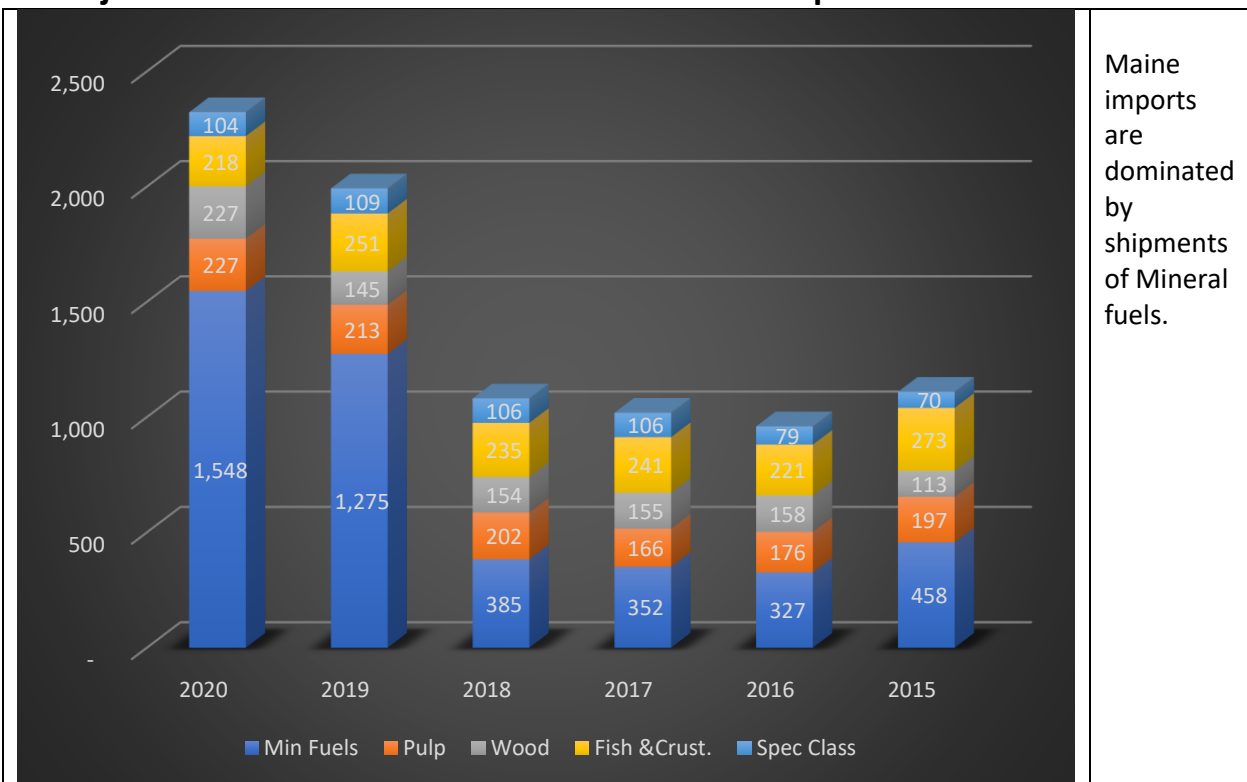
Imports dominate Maine - Canada trade at about 62% over the six-year period. Exports comprise about 38% of total trade conducted by Maine.

3. Major Commodities of Maine – Canada Trade: Exports

Top exports from Maine to Canada include shipments of primary products with aircraft being among the top five in 2020.

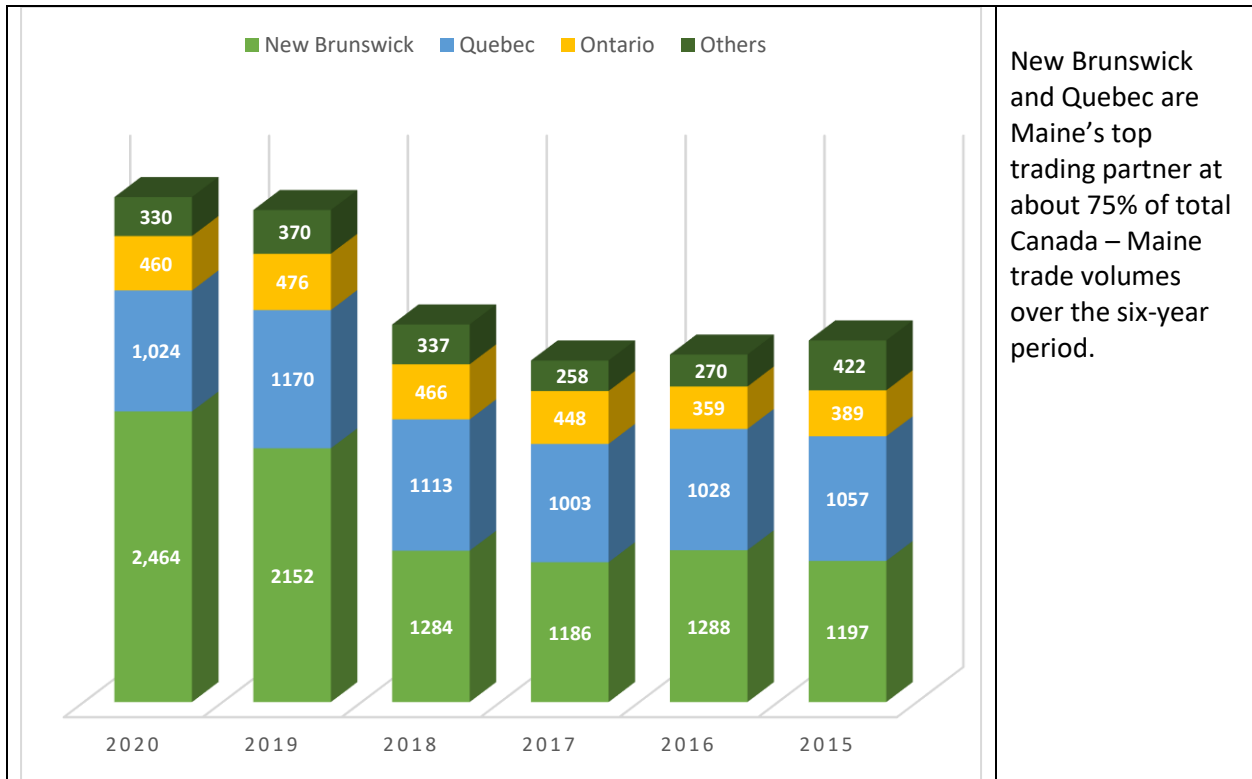


4. Major Commodities of Maine – Canada Trade: Imports

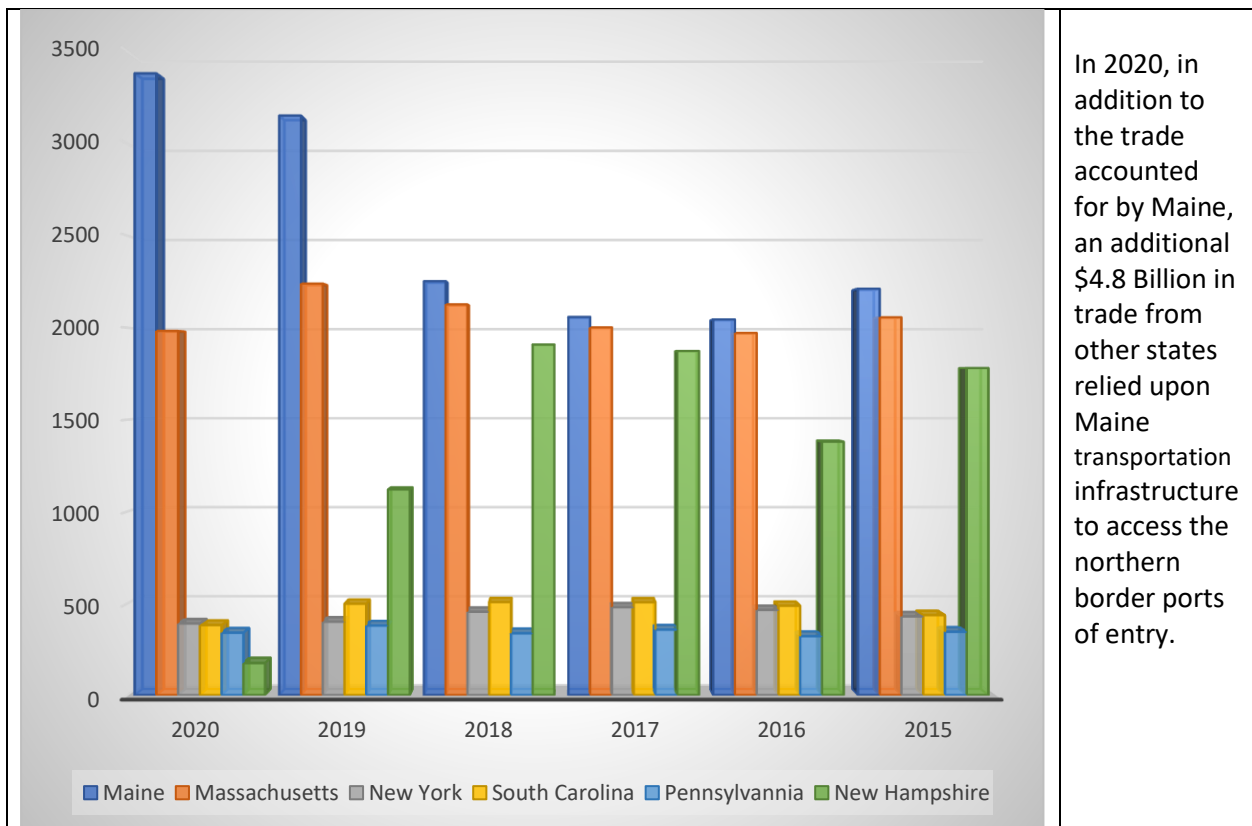


Maine imports are dominated by shipments of Mineral fuels.

5. TOP TRADING PARTNERS: Maine – Canadian Provinces

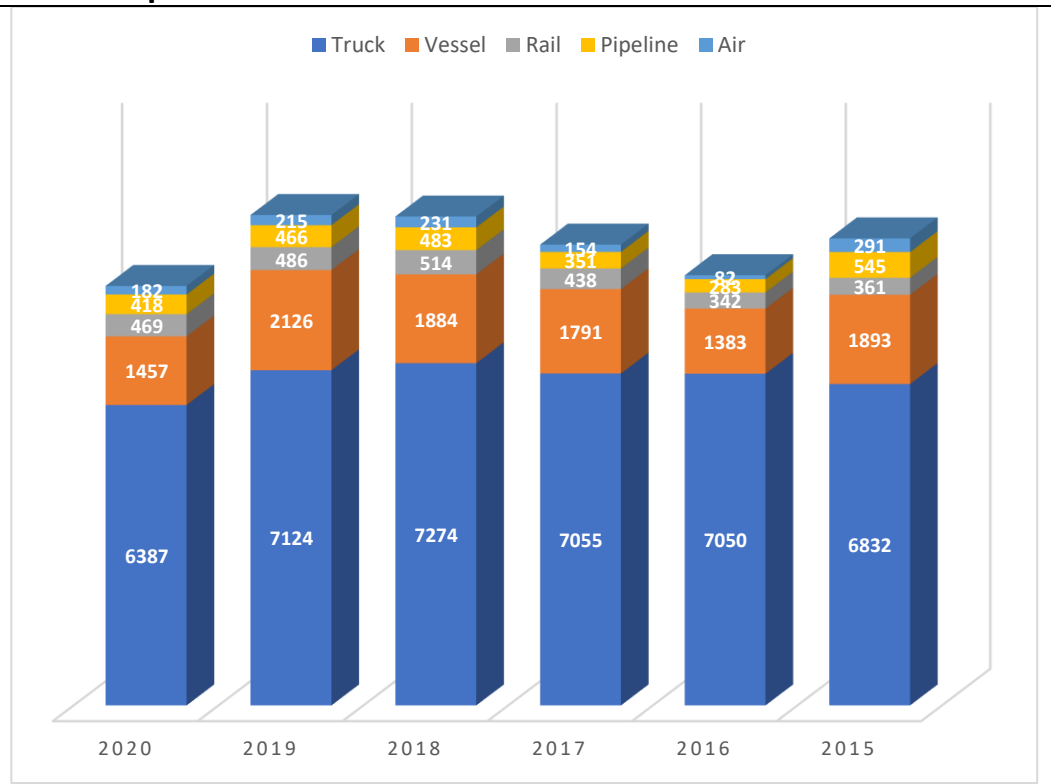


6. TOP STATES TRADING WITH CANADA THROUGH MAINE

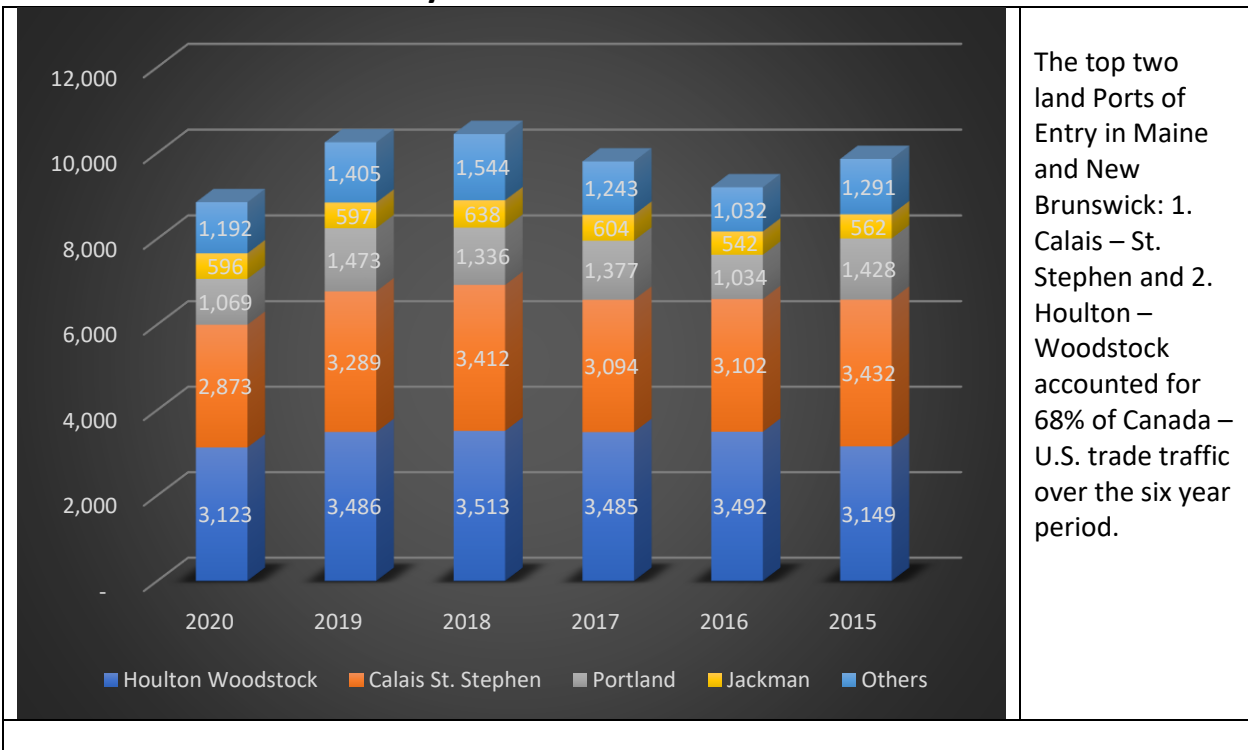


7. TOP MODES of Transportation: Canada - US TRADE THROUGH Maine

The bulk of Canada US trade, 70%, that passes through Maine travels via truck. Close to 80% of this pass through truck traffic are exports and about 70% are imports. Vessel accounts for 20% of total, rail and pipeline 5% each.



8. TOP Maine Ports of Entry for Canada – US Trade



The top two land Ports of Entry in Maine and New Brunswick: 1. Calais – St. Stephen and 2. Houlton – Woodstock accounted for 68% of Canada – U.S. trade traffic over the six year period.
