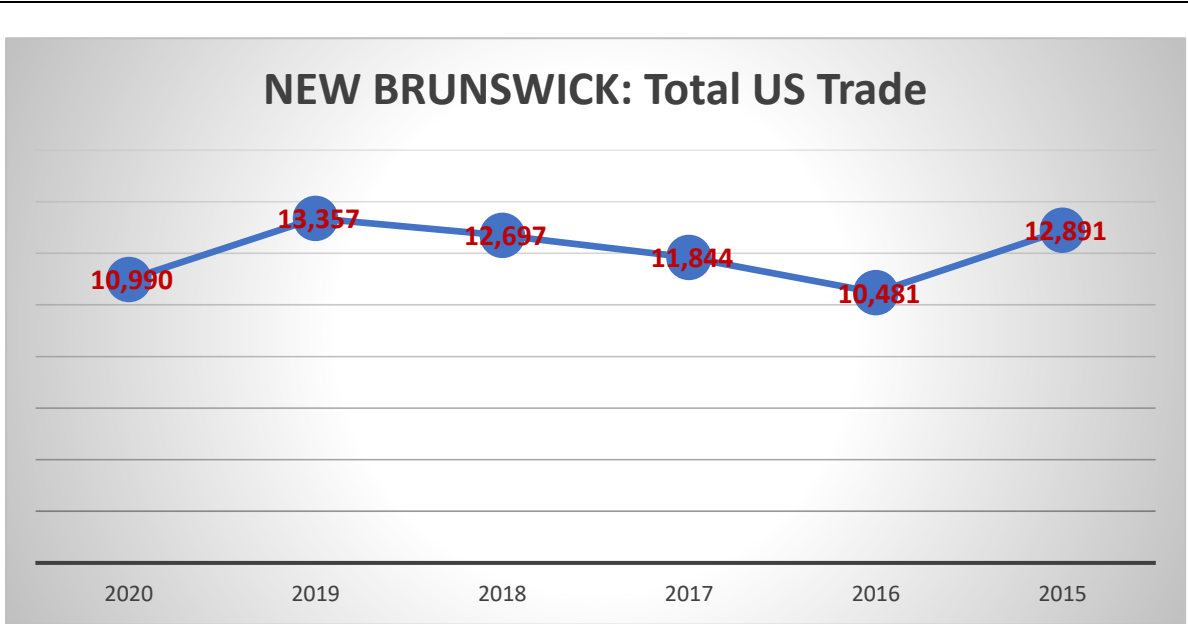


NEW BRUNSWICK – U.S. Trade (US\$)

1. Total New Brunswick – US Trade – Exports and Imports (US \$M)

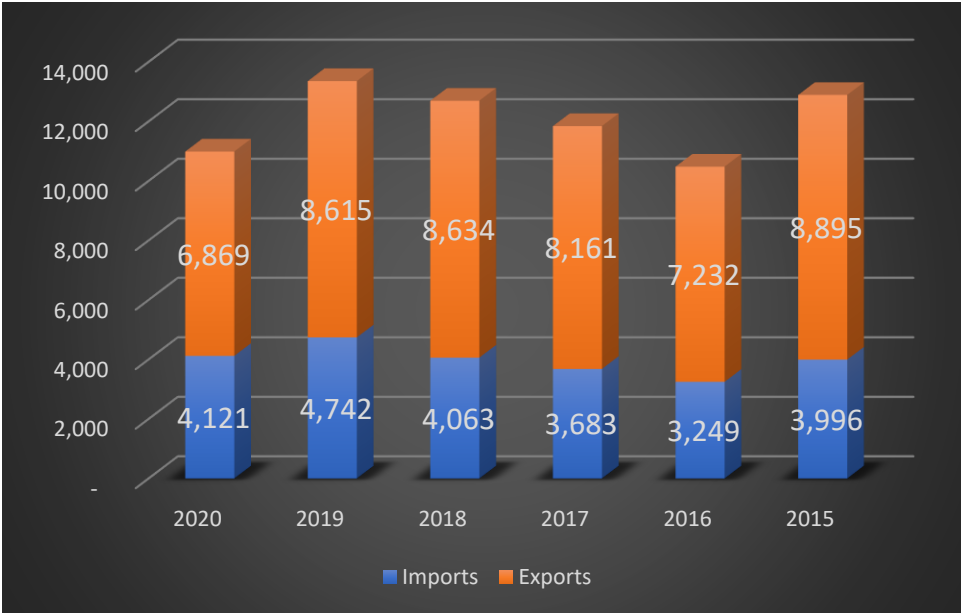
In 2020, total NB - US trade declined by \$2.4 Billion from \$13.4 billion in 2019, to \$11 billion in 2020. This drop was comprised of a 25% decline in exports and a 15% decline in imports.



2. New Brunswick – Share of Exports / Imports U.S. – New Brunswick Trade

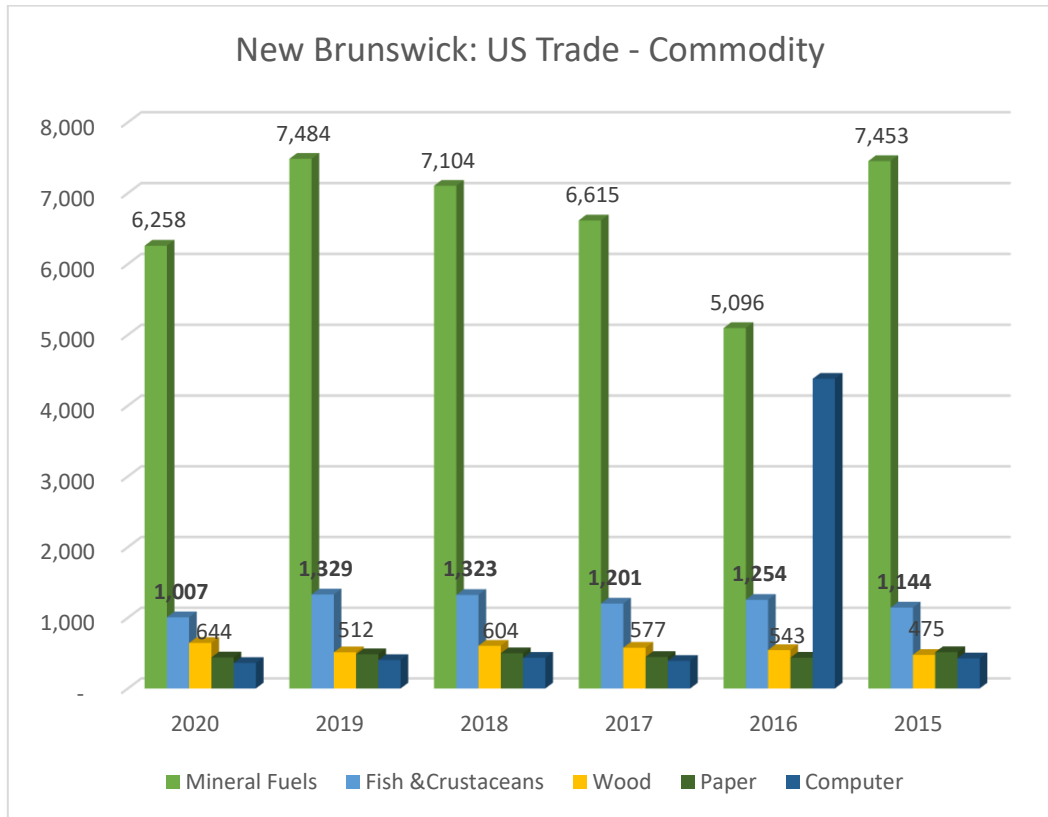
Exports dominate New Brunswick – U.S. trade at about 67% of total trade over the six-year period.

Imports comprise about 33% of total trade conducted by New Brunswick with the U.S.

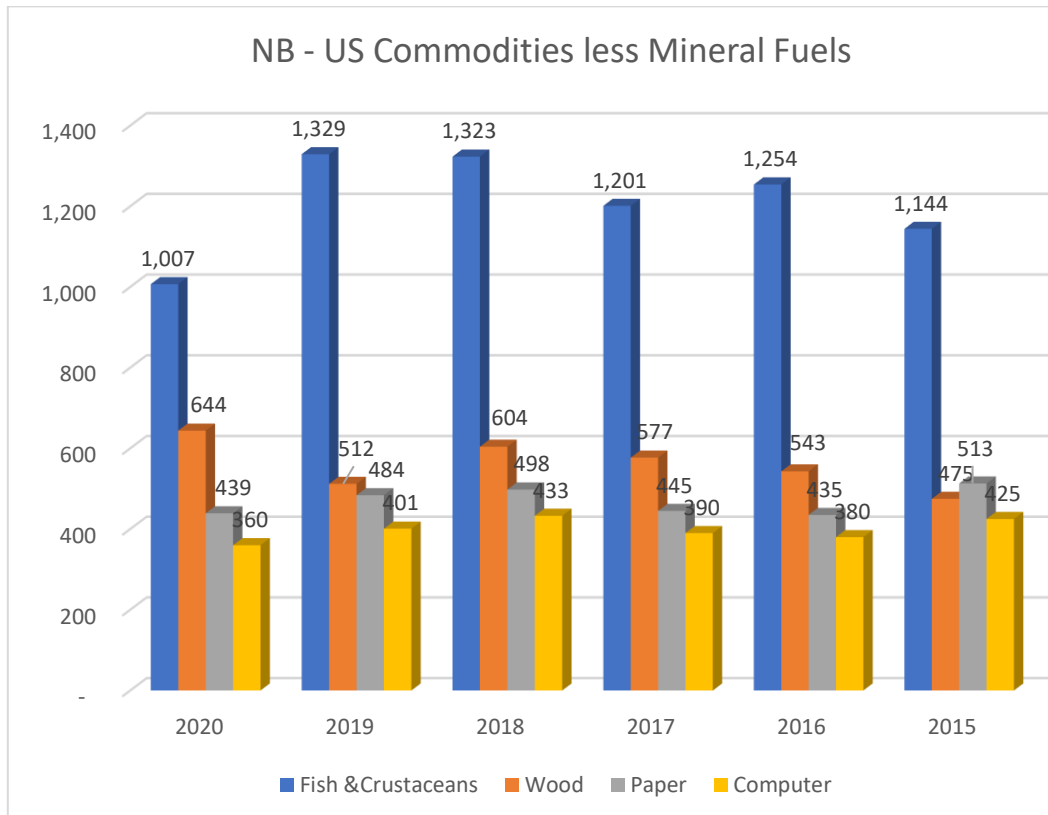


3. Major Commodities of NB - US Trade: Total

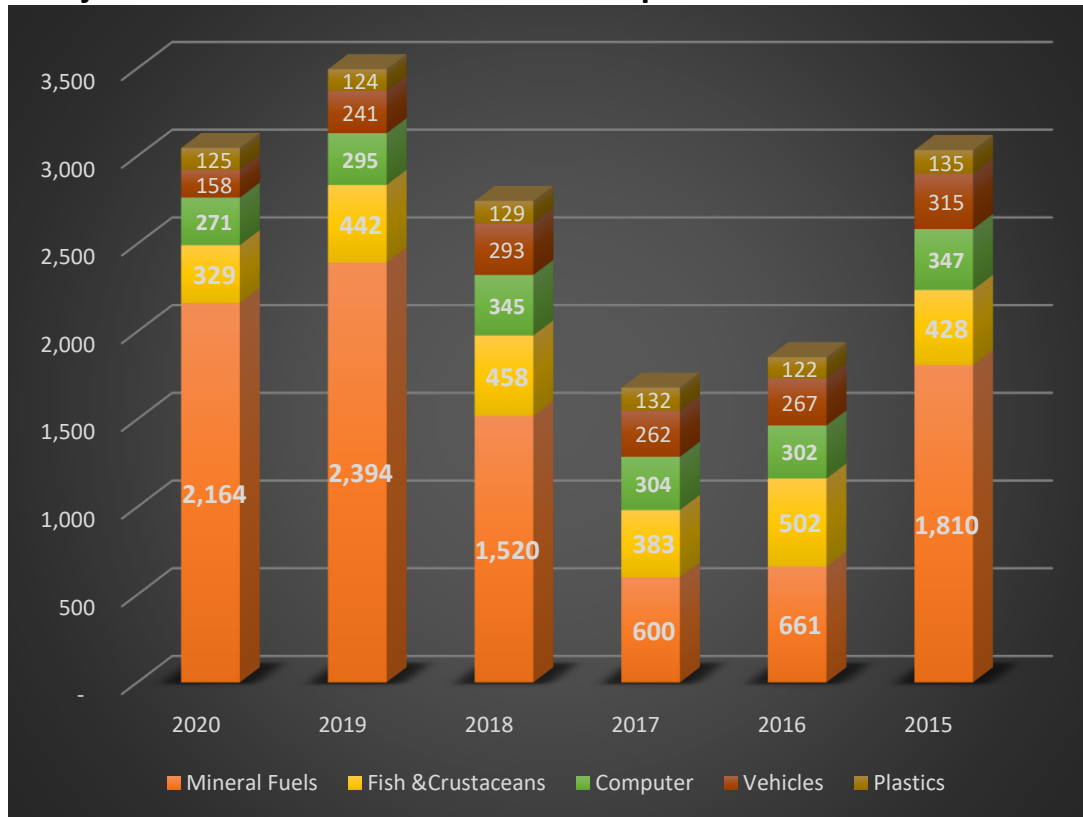
Over half, (55%) of total New Brunswick – U.S. trade in the six- year period is Mineral fuels.



Removing the Mineral Fuels category from total trade shows the role of seafood in N.B. - U.S. trade.



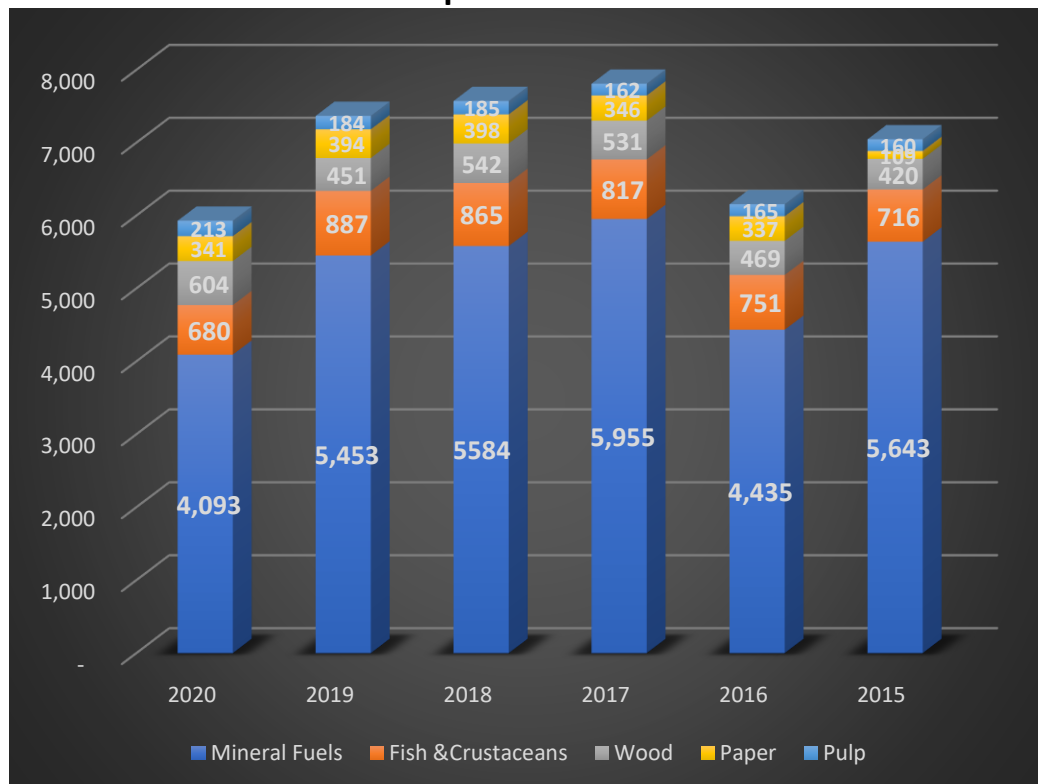
4. Major Commodities of NB US Trade: Imports



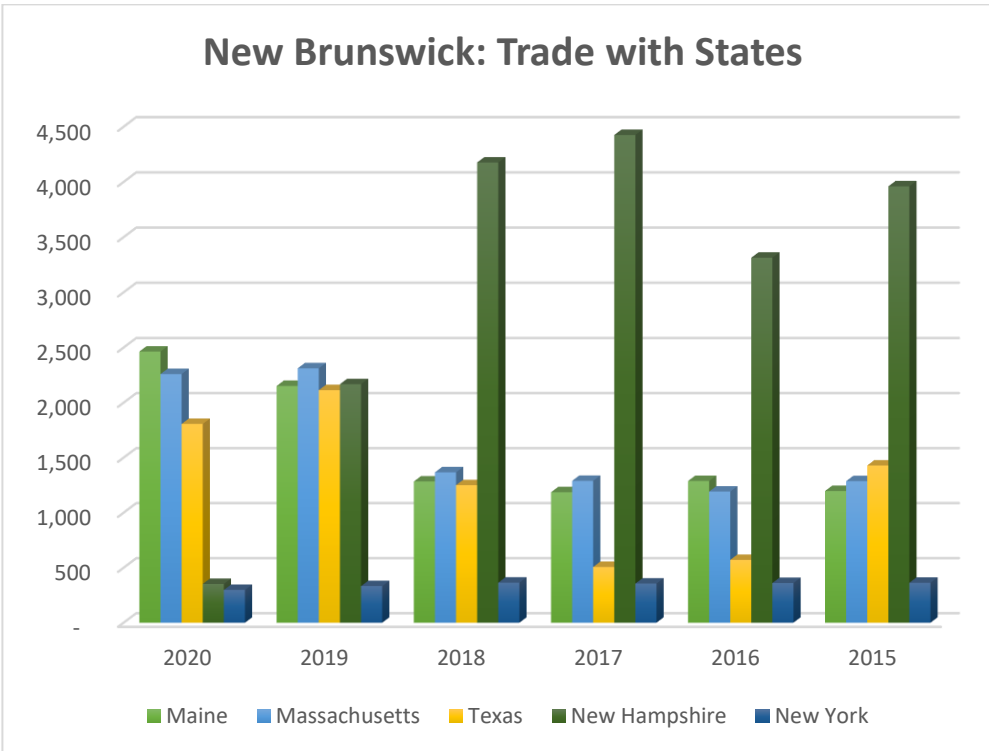
Top N. B. imports: mineral fuels, seafood, computers and vehicles.

5. Major Commodities of NB US Trade: Exports

N.B. – U.S. exports are mainly mineral fuels followed by fish and crustaceans wood, pulp and paper: primary products.

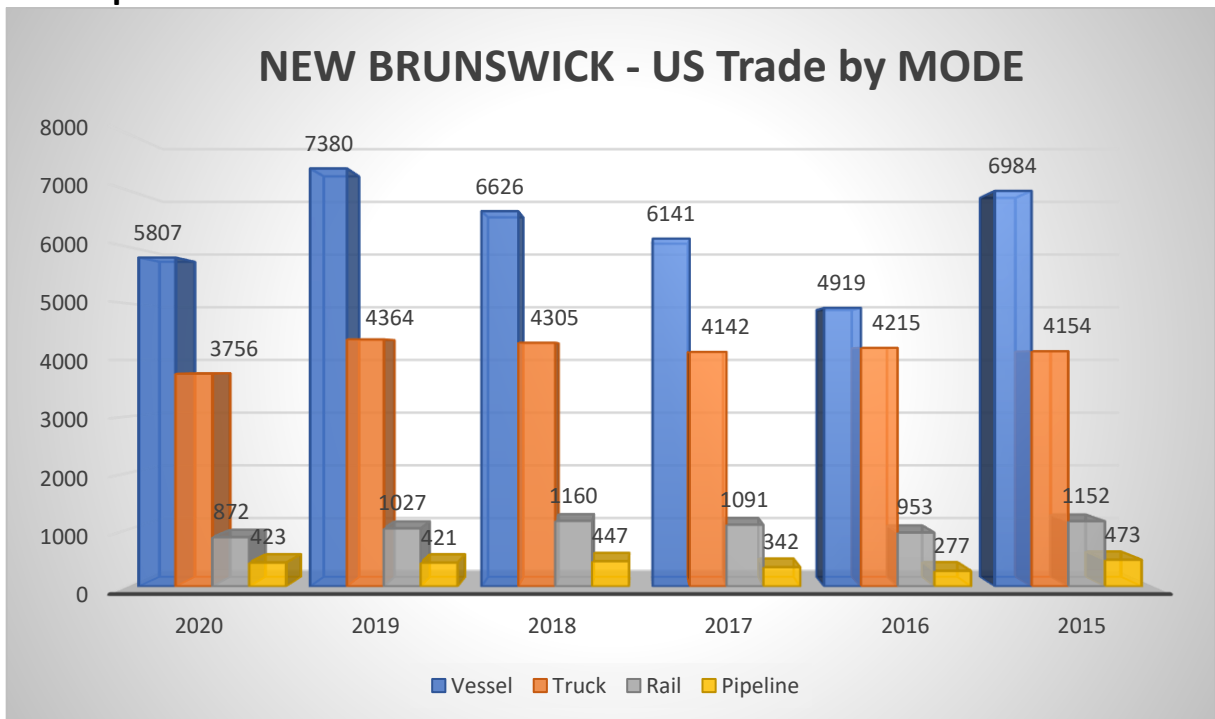


6. TOP U.S. TRADING PARTNERS

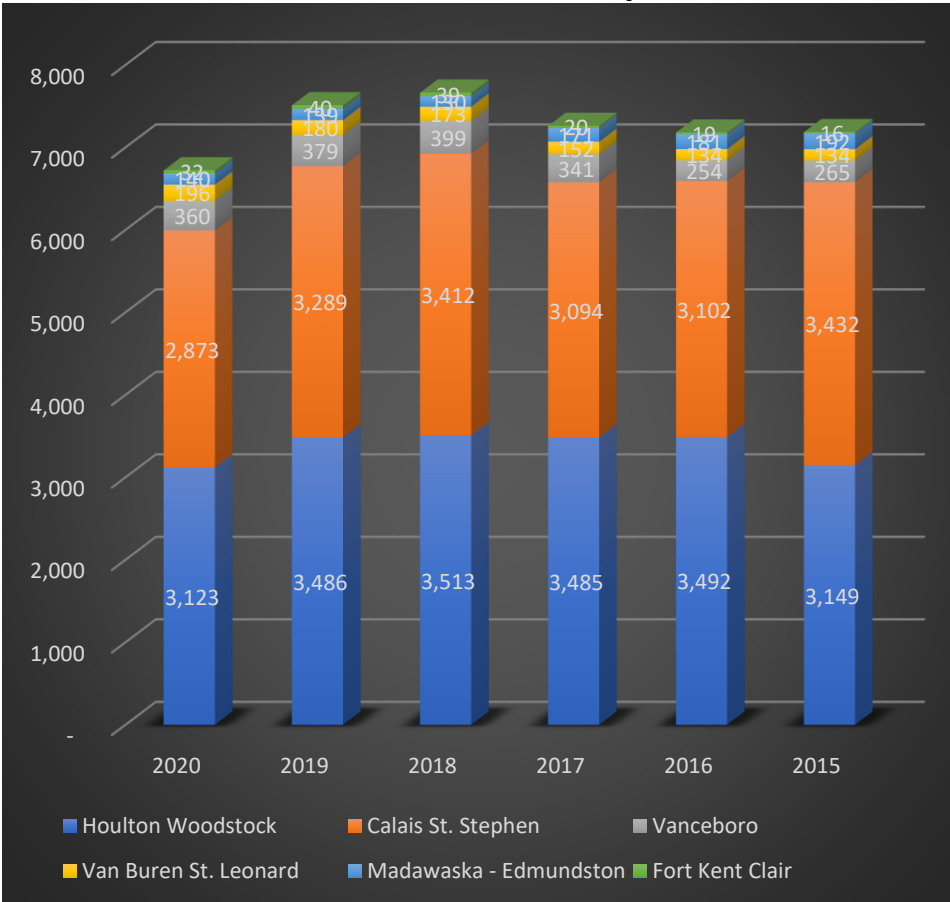


In 2019, 2020, Maine, Massachusetts and Texas were N.B.'s top trading partners.

8. TOP New Brunswick Land Ports of Entry for Canada – US Trade



The top two Ports of Entry account for 90% of N.B. / Canada – U.S. trade traffic.

This chart excludes the significant mineral fuels trade via Vessel – in 2020 the major Ports of Entry for this trade were Portland Maine, Boston, Mass, and Dallas and Houston Texas.
