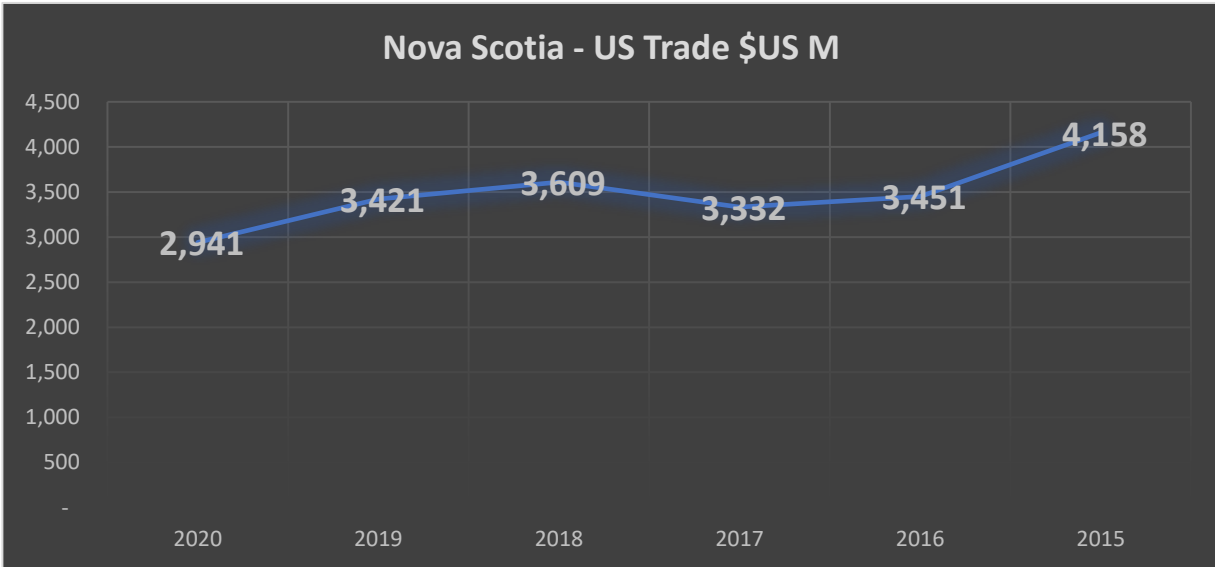


## 1. Total Nova Scotia – US Trade – Exports and Imports (US \$M)

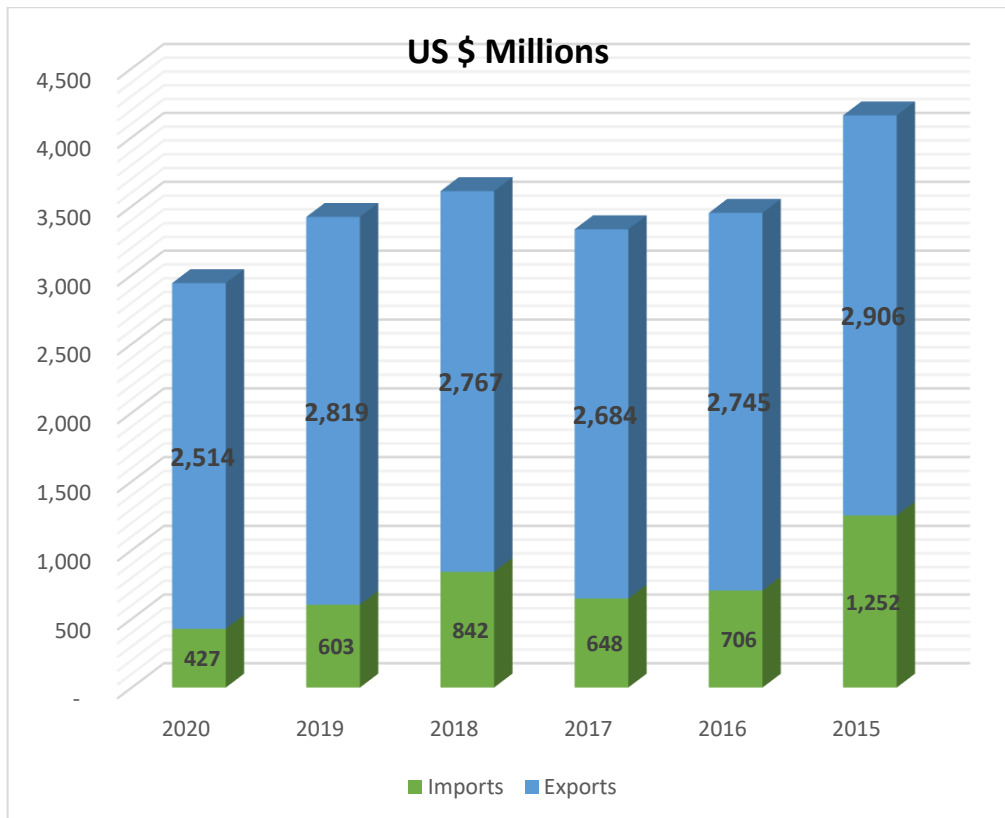
In 2020, total NS - US trade declined by \$480 Million from \$3.4 billion in 2019, to \$2.9 billion in 2020. This drop was comprised of a 12% decline in exports and a 41% decline in imports.



## 2. Nova Scotia – Share of Exports / Imports U.S. – Nova Scotia Trade

Exports dominate Nova Scotia – U.S. trade at about 80% of total trade over the six-year period.

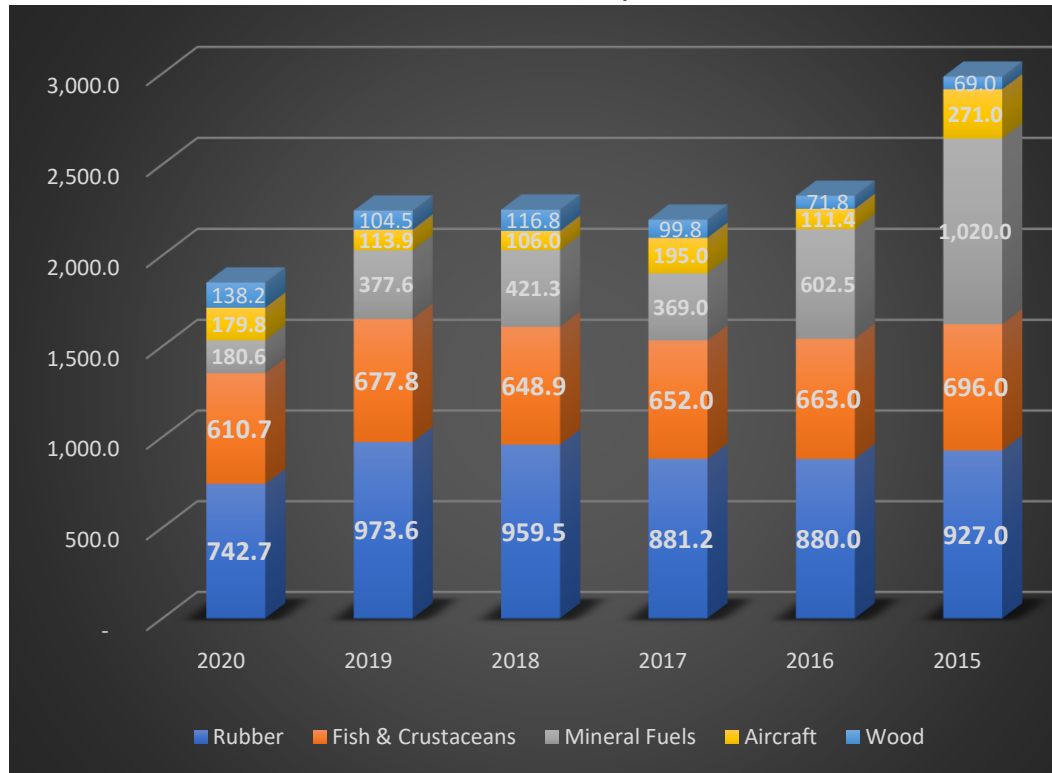
Imports comprise about 20% of total trade conducted by Nova Scotia with the U.S.



### 3. Major Commodities of N.S. – U.S. Trade: Total US\$M

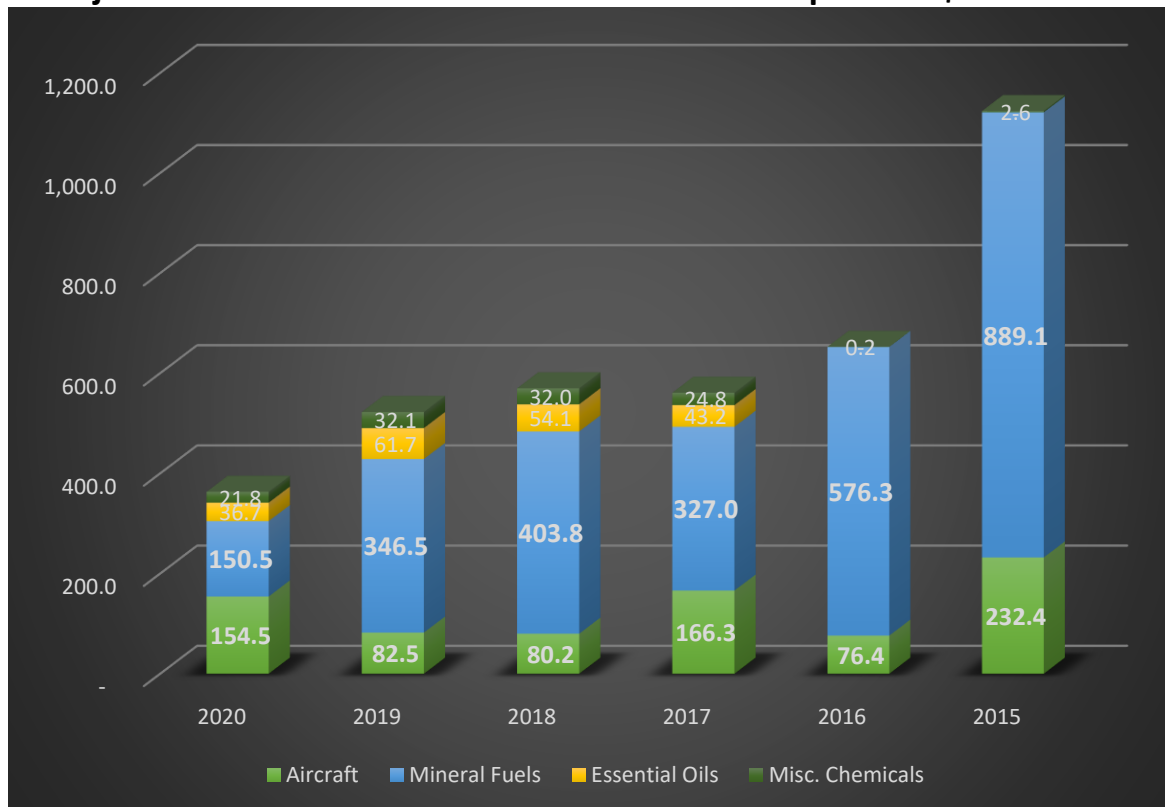
Over half, (56%) of total Nova Scotia – U.S. trade in the six-year period is from the top three commodities

1. Rubber
2. Seafood
3. Mineral fuels.



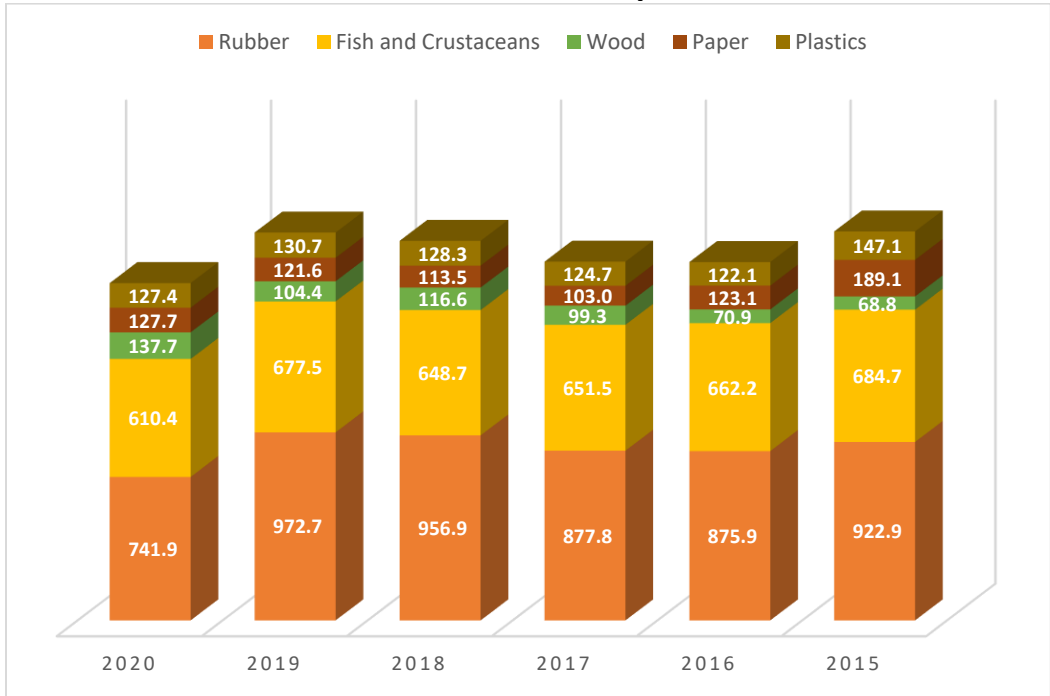
### 4. Major Commodities of Nova Scotia - US Trade: Imports US\$M

Top N. S. imports: aircraft, and mineral fuels.

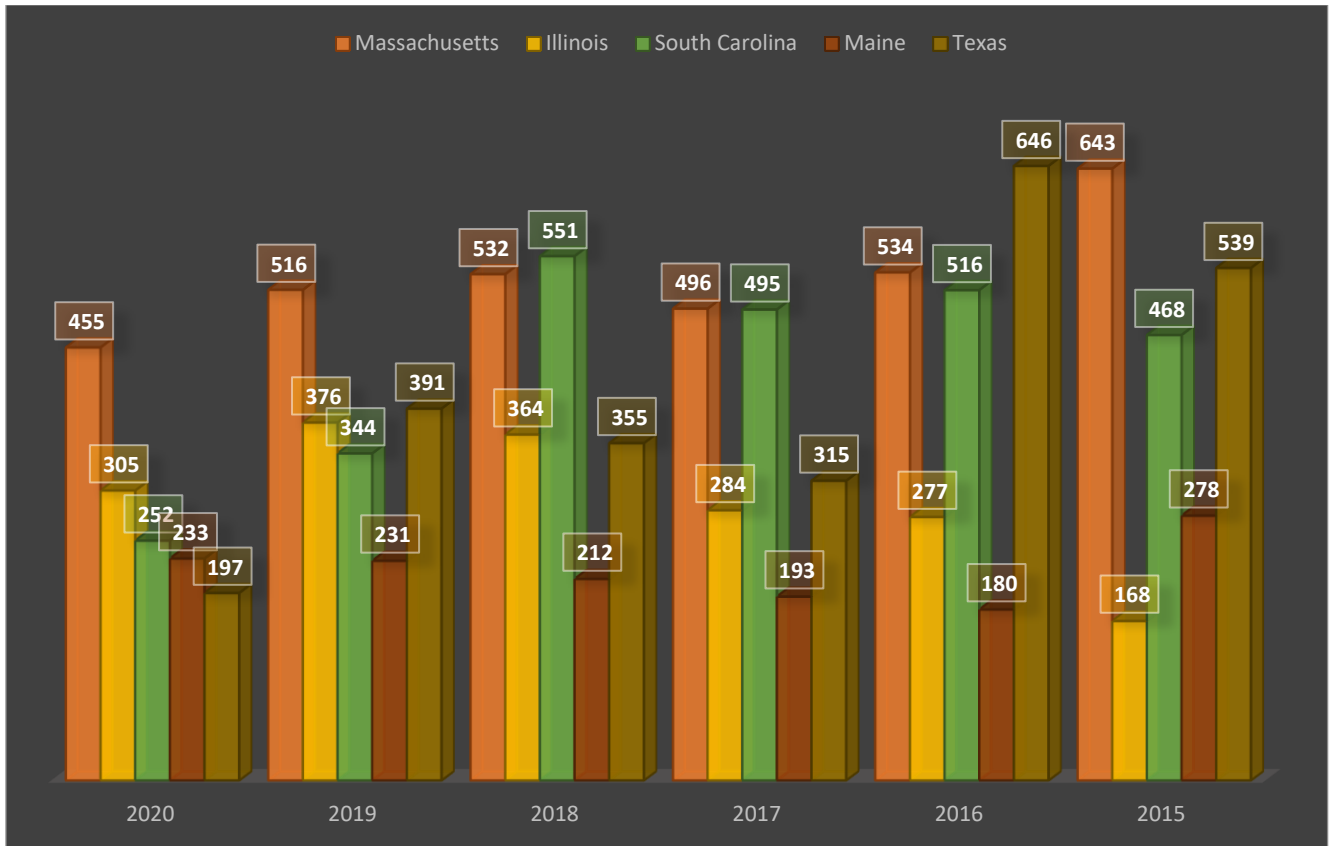


### 5. Major Commodities of Nova Scotia – U.S. Trade: Exports US\$M

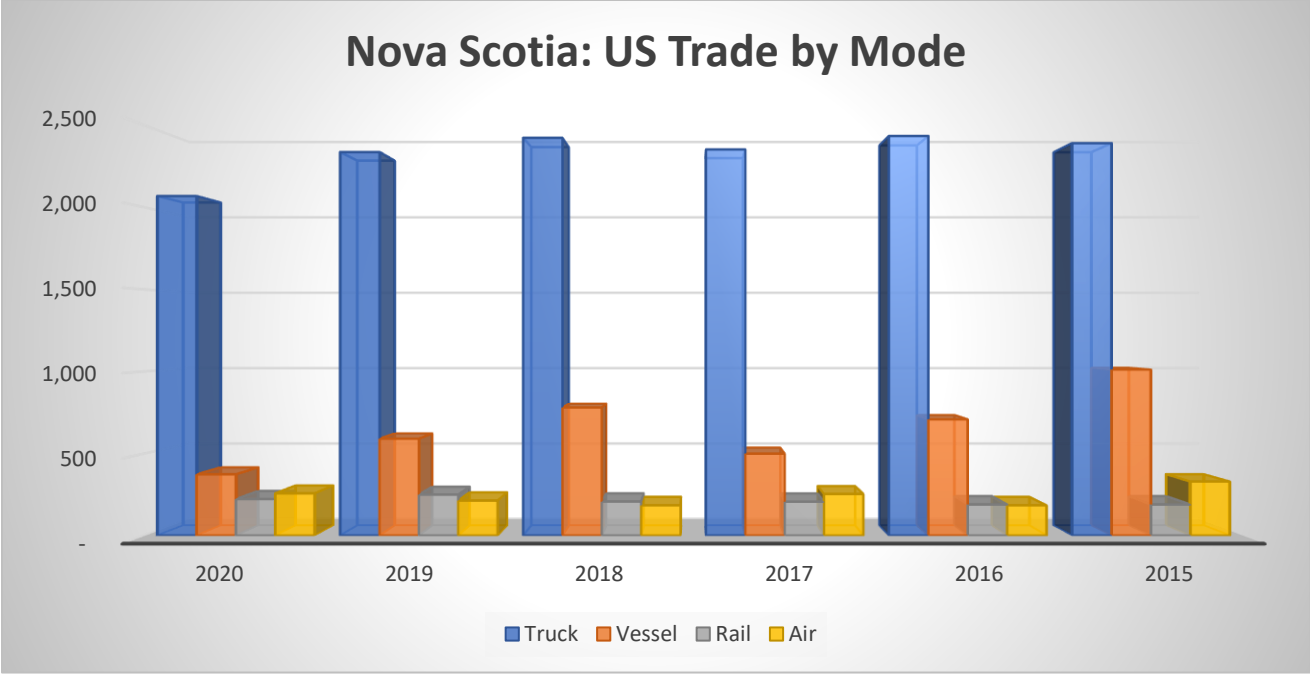
Top N.S. – U.S. exports are rubber and seafood products.
