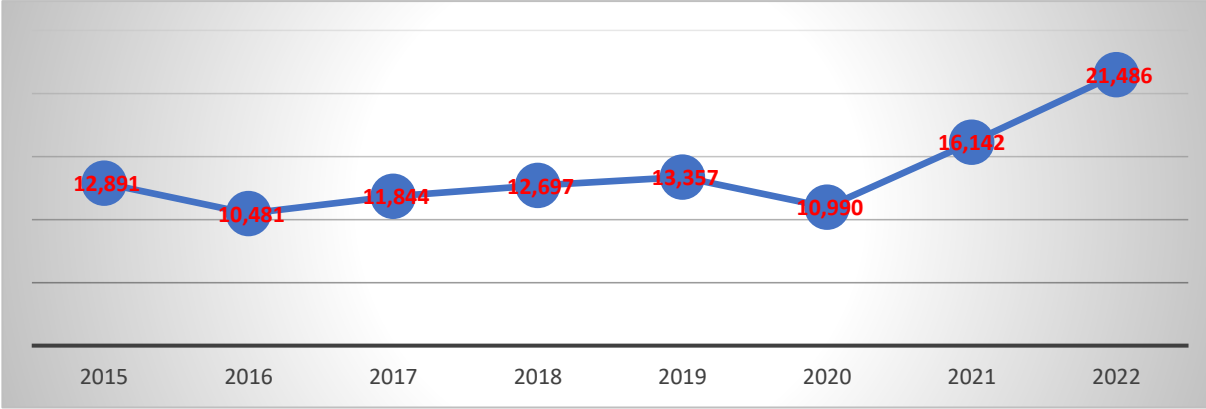


# NEW BRUNSWICK – U.S. Trade (US\$)

## 1. Total New Brunswick – US Trade – Exports and Imports (US \$M)

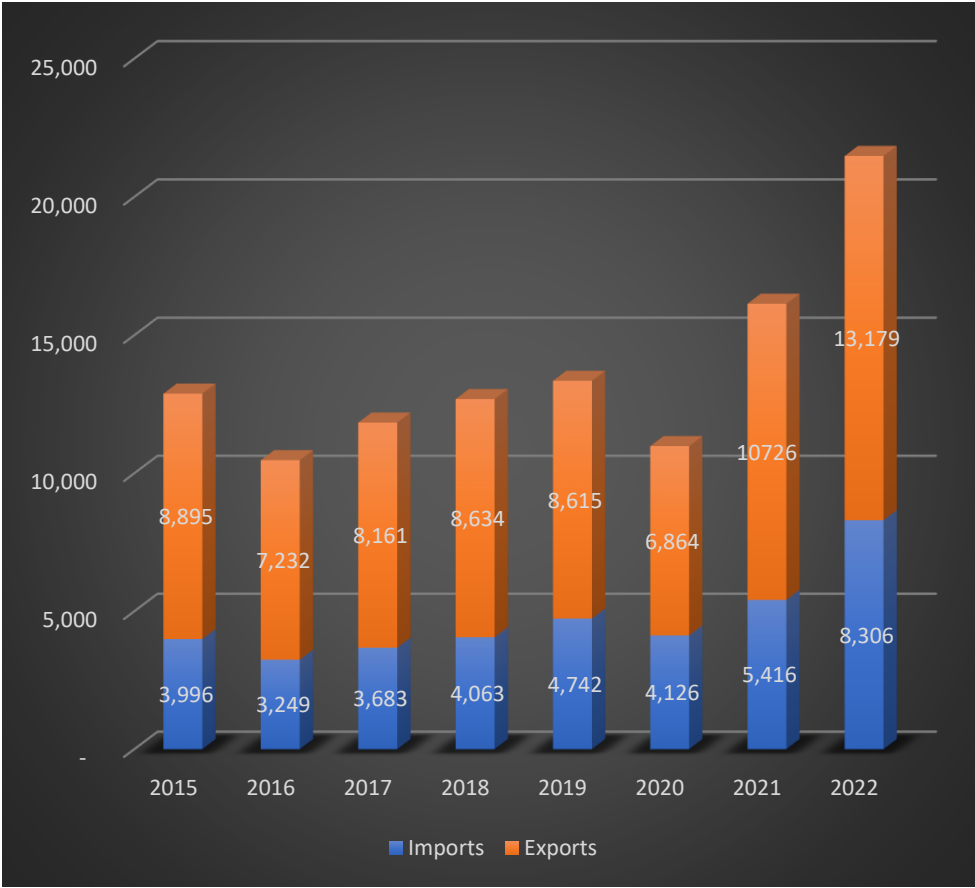
Total NB - US trade increased by \$5.3 Billion from \$16 billion in 2021, to \$21 billion in 2022. This was comprised of a \$2.5 billion increase in exports and a \$2.9 billion increase in imports.



## 2. New Brunswick – Share of Exports / Imports U.S. – New Brunswick Trade \$M

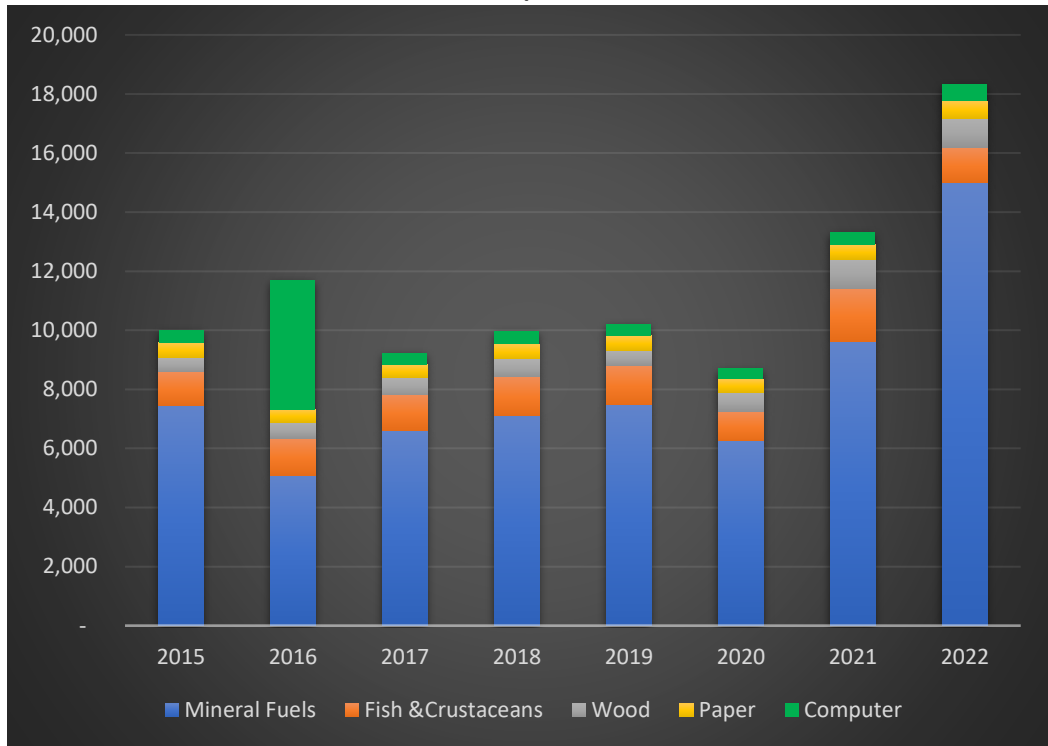
Exports dominate New Brunswick – U.S. trade at about 66% of total trade over the eight-year period.

Imports comprise about 34% of total trade conducted by New Brunswick with the U.S.



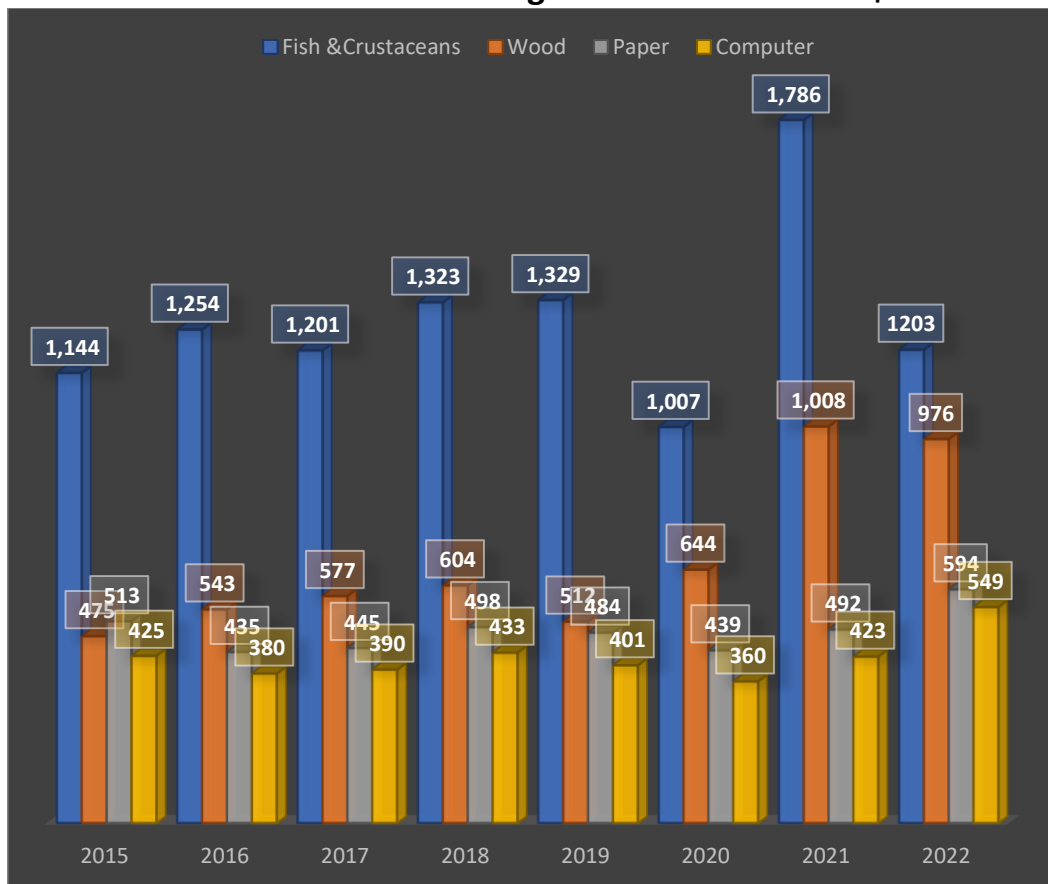
### 3. Major Commodities of NB - US Trade: Total \$M US

Over half, (60%) of total New Brunswick – U.S. trade in the eight-year period is Mineral fuels.

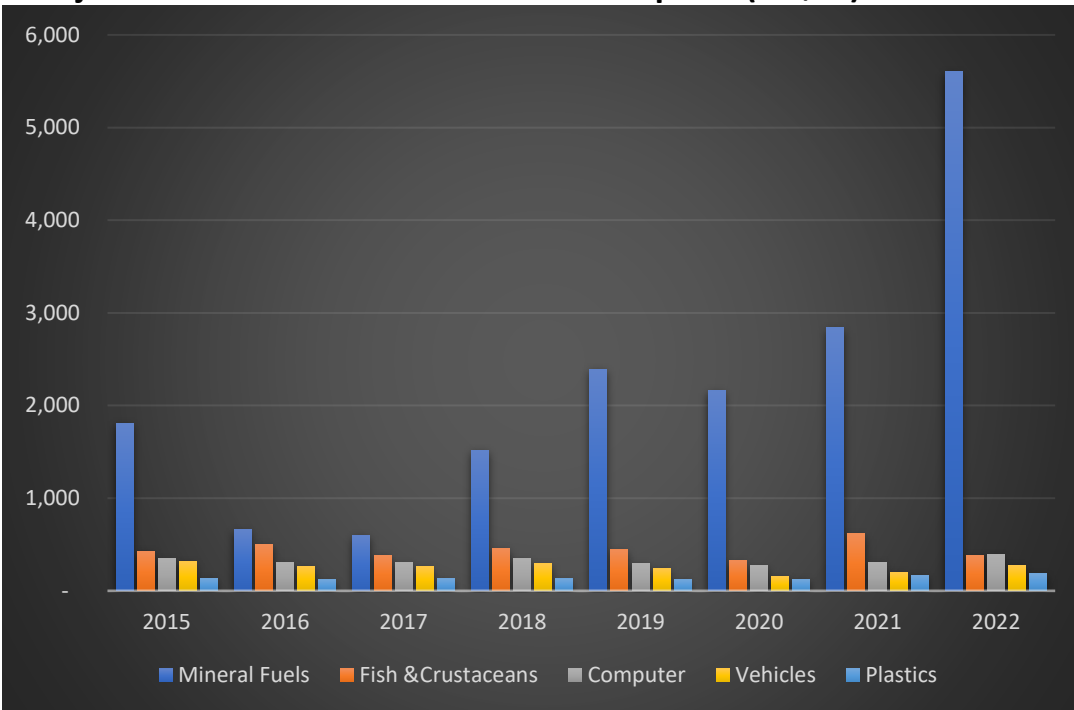


### Major Commodities of NB - US Trade Excluding Mineral Fuels: Total \$M US

Removing the Mineral Fuels category from total NB – U.S. trade shows the key role of seafood in N.B. - U.S. trade.



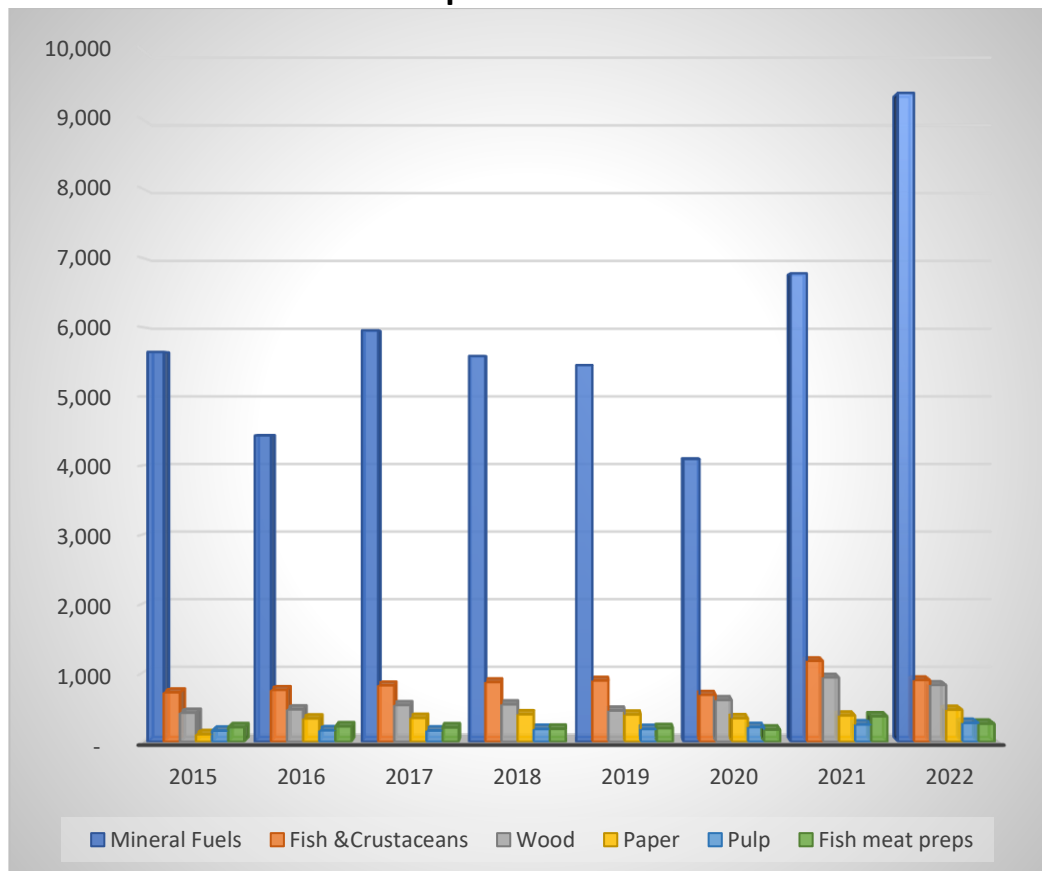
#### 4. Major Commodities of NB - US Trade: Imports (US\$M)



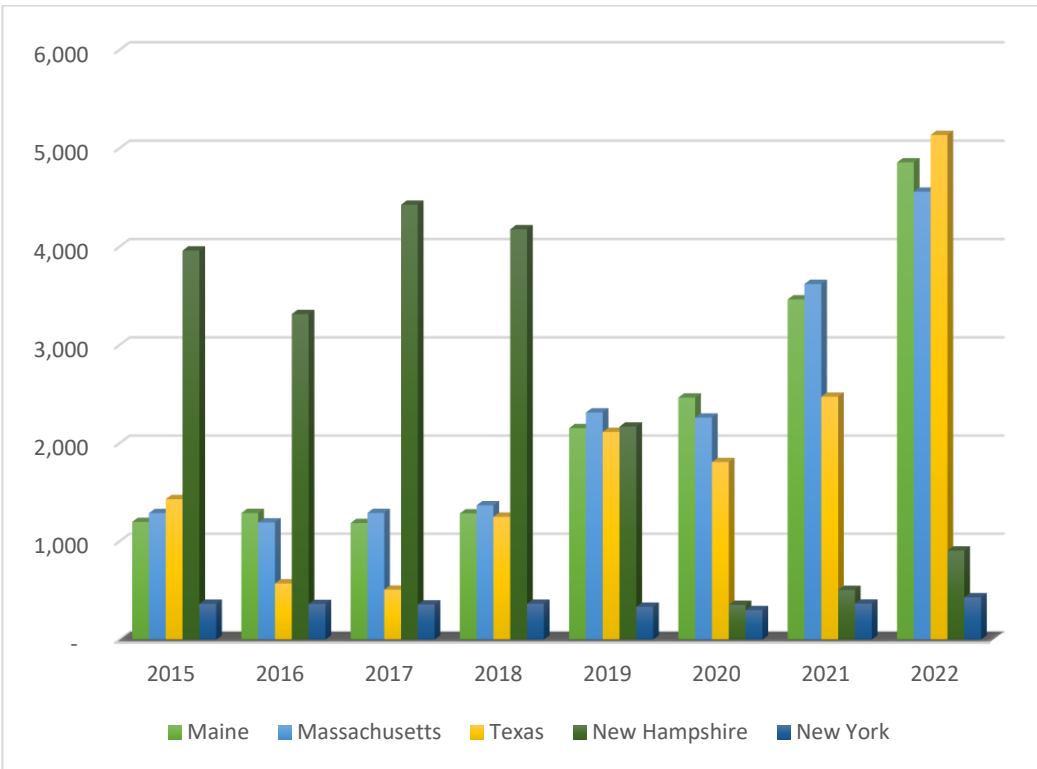
Top N. B. imports from the U.S. are mineral fuels, seafood, computers and vehicles.

#### 5. Major Commodities of NB US Trade: Exports

N.B. exports to the U.S. are mineral fuels, fish and crustaceans wood, pulp and paper.



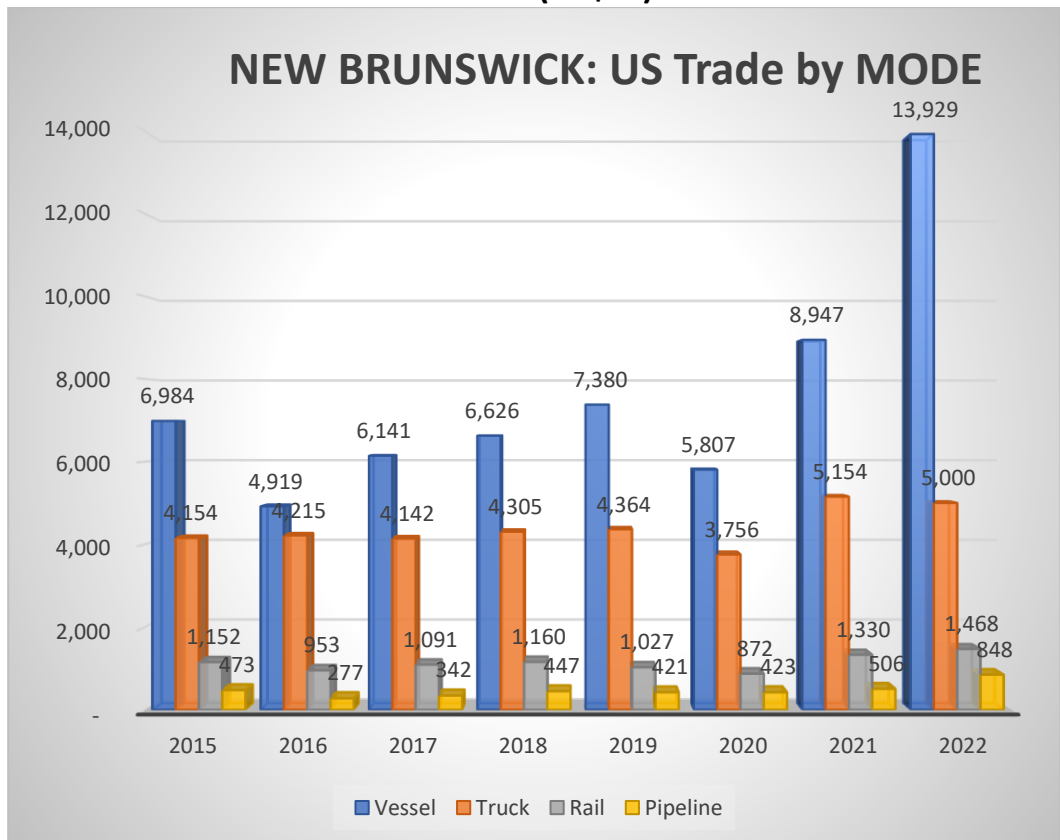
## 6. TOP U.S. TRADING PARTNERS : New Brunswick and States

## 7. TOP Shipment Modes of N.B. – U.S. TRADE (US\$M)

In 2022, 66% of NB – US total trade was transported by vessel. Trucks are second at about 24%.
