Bring world-class passenger rail service to regions across the country



Grow a safer, cleaner, more equitable rail system



Corridor ID creates a foundational framework for identifying and developing new or improved intercity passenger rail (IPR) services. Under the program, FRA will:

Solicit proposal for implementing new or improving existing IPR services

Select corridors for development

Partner with corridor sponsor to prepare (or update) a Service Development Plan (SDP)

SDP includes a "corridor project inventory"

Corridor project inventories populate a prioritized "pipeline" of projects

Projects in the Corridor ID Pipeline are eligible for funding under FRA's financial assistance programs

Cross Border Improvements

West

Transition from pre-inspection to preclearance at Vancouver Pacific Central Station for *Amtrak*Cascades

Working towards sterile corridor enhancements

Central

Wolverine extension from Chicago/Detroit <> Windsor connecting to VIA Rail service

CBP preclearance and CBSA arrivals at VIA Station in Windsor

Project development/design and funding requests in Canada are underway

East

CBP preclearance and CBSA arrivals at Montreal Central Station

Serves *Adirondack* and future expansion (*Vermonter* extension and *Adirondack* improvements)

Eliminate stops in both directions at Rouses Point/Lacolle for the *Adirondack*

Québec government completing concept design for Montreal facility



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




Eastern Border Transportation Michigan CIDP




Wolverine Corridor: Detroit/Pontiac – Chicago, with Proposed Expansion to Windsor/Toronto





Blue Water Corridor: Port Huron – Chicago







New Corridor: Cleveland – Toledo – Detroit

- Co-applicant with Ohio Rail Development Commission
- Proposed new service corridor connecting existing Wolverine with Lake Shore Limited and Capitol Limited long-distance services
- Routing and stations to be determined through SDP process









Adirondack Corridor



- Currently in **phase 1**: to develop scope, costs, and timeline of the planning process.
- 2006 I-87 Multimodal Corridor Study was the last time NYSDOT studied this corridor.
- Overarching goals and objectives:
 - Incremental, operational enhancements to different segments of the corridor that will reduce travel times and improve customer experience.
 - An additional second daily trip
 - Pre-clearance facility in Montreal



Montreal Preclearance Inspection Facility

- NYS supports the consolidation of US Customs and Border Protection (USCBP) and Canada Border Services Admin (CBSA) inspections of Amtrak's Adirondack in a single facility in Gare Central, Montreal
- Eliminates dwell time at the border in each direction for inspections
- Improves schedule unreliability with inspections to occur prior to departure (SB) or after arrival (NB).



Next Steps...

- Currently in preliminary stages to develop the scope and schedule.
- NYSDOT will begin external outreach for both corridors in **phase II.**
- Strong coordination with our partners in Canada is anticipated during this phase.
