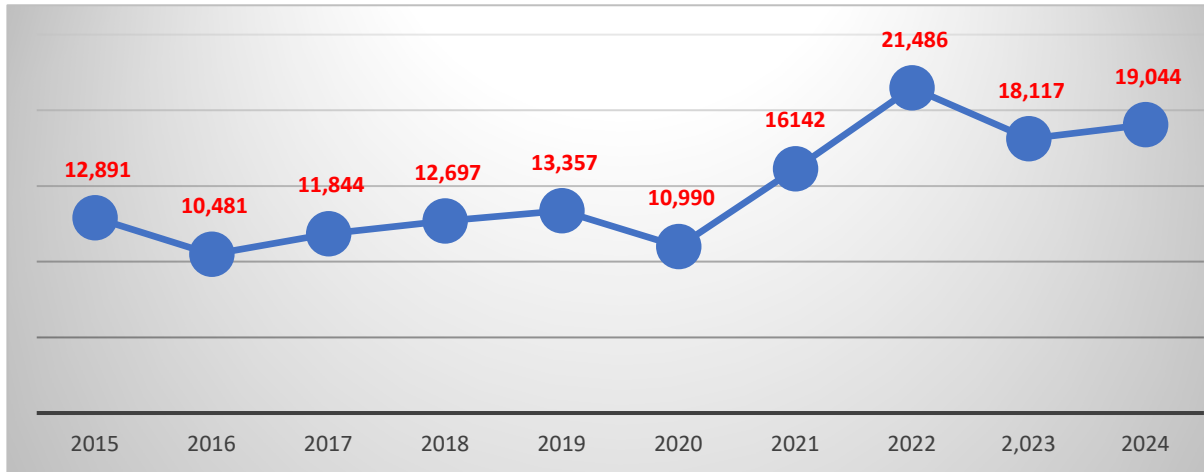


NEW BRUNSWICK – U.S. Trade (US\$)

1. Total New Brunswick – US Trade – Exports and Imports (US \$M)

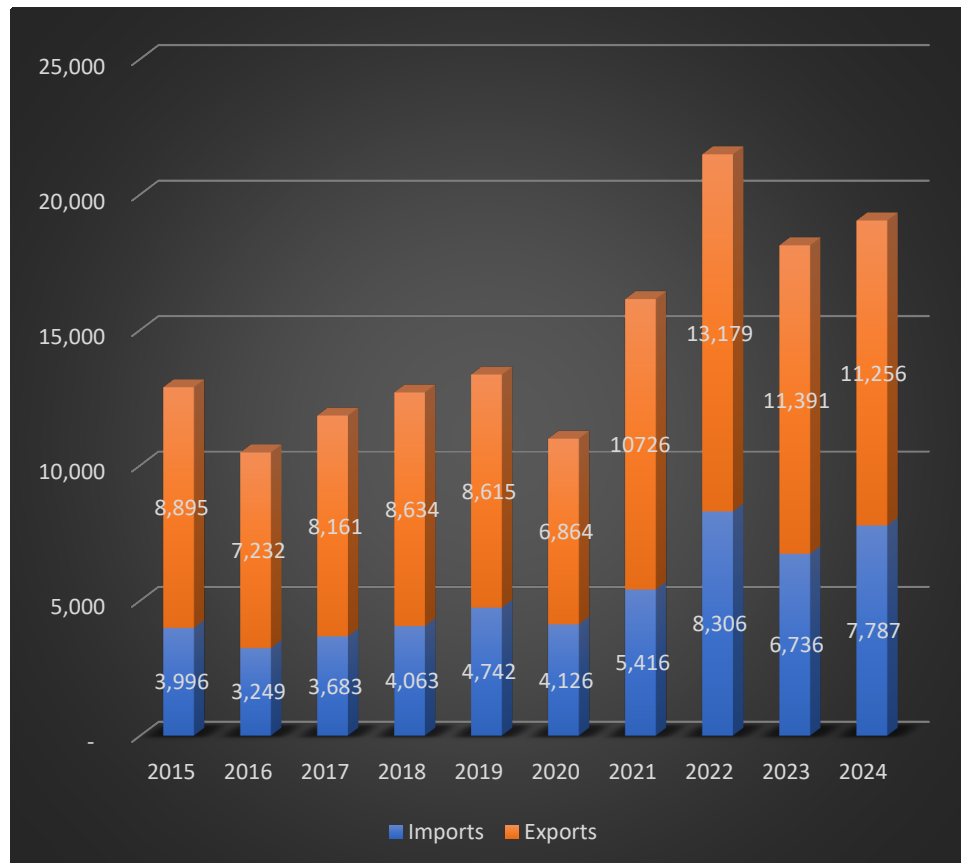
Total NB - US trade increased by \$927 million from \$18 billion in 2023, to \$19 billion in 2024. This was comprised of a \$135 million decrease in exports and a \$1 billion increase in imports.



2. New Brunswick – Share of Exports / Imports U.S. – New Brunswick Trade \$M

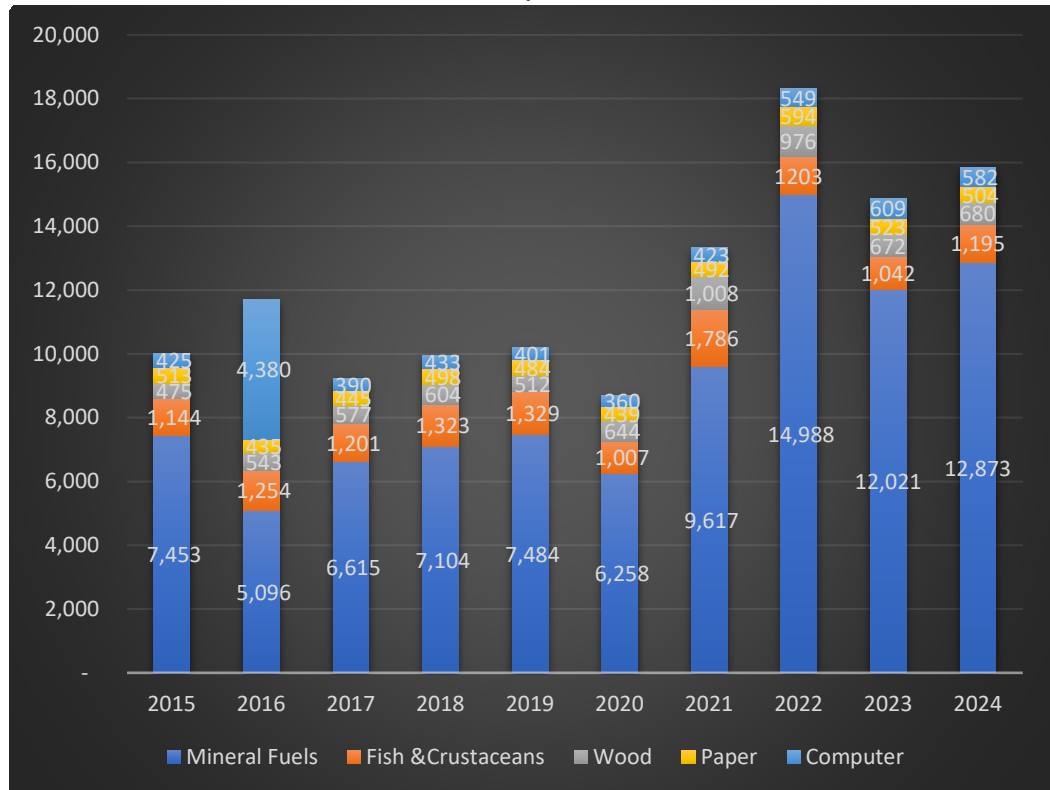
Exports dominate New Brunswick – U.S. trade at about 65% of total trade over the ten-year period.

Imports comprise about 35% of total trade between New Brunswick and the U.S.



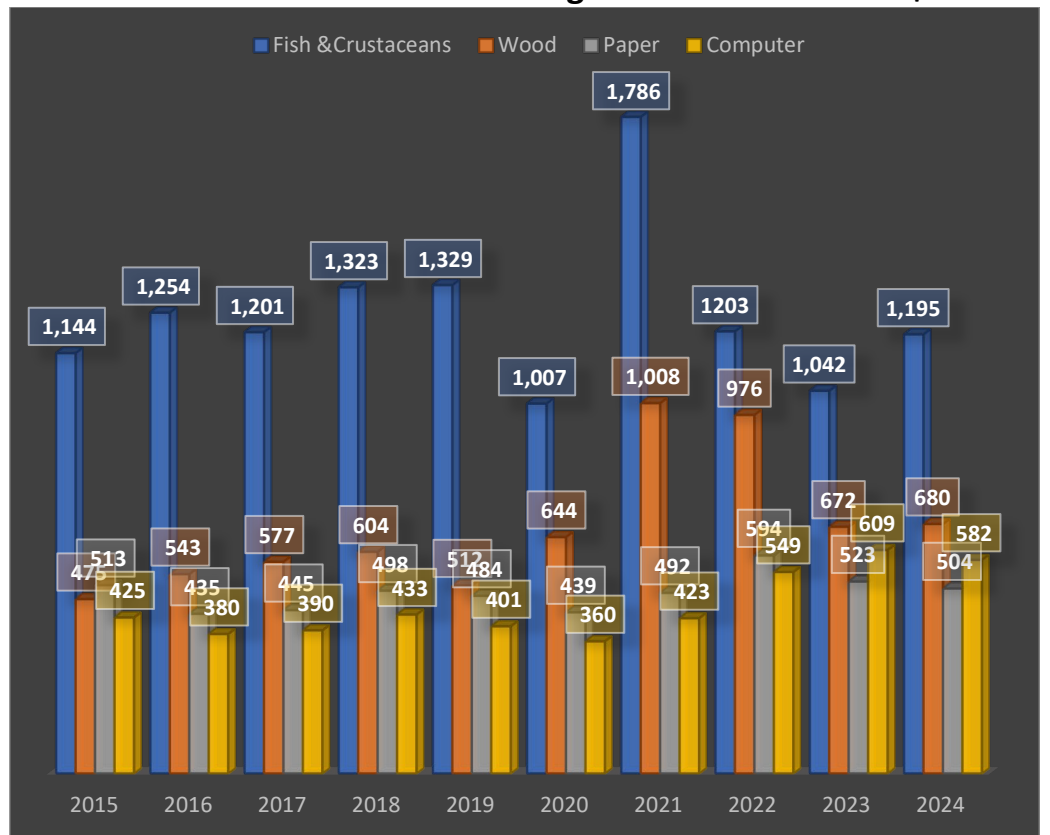
3. Major Commodities of NB - US Trade: Total \$M US

Over half, (61%) of total New Brunswick – U.S. trade in the ten-year period is Mineral fuels.

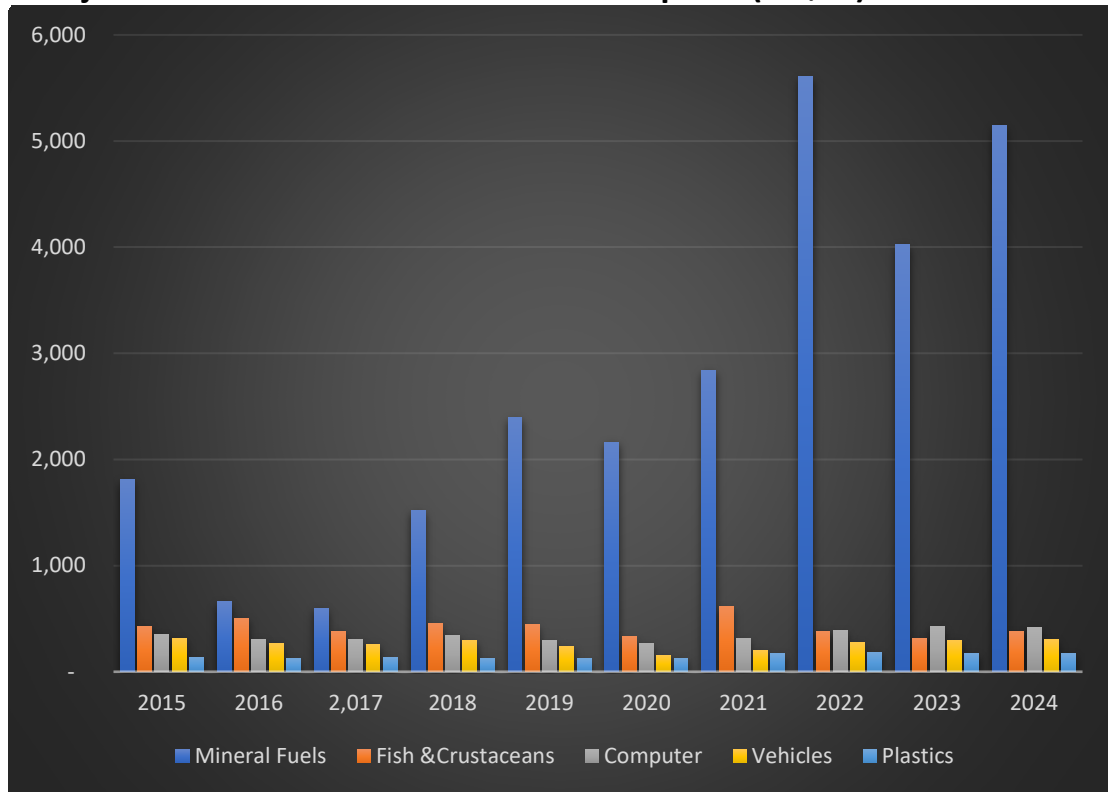


4. Major Commodities of NB - US Trade Excluding Mineral Fuels: Total \$M US

Removing the Mineral Fuels category from total NB – U.S. trade shows the key role of seafood in N.B. - U.S. trade.



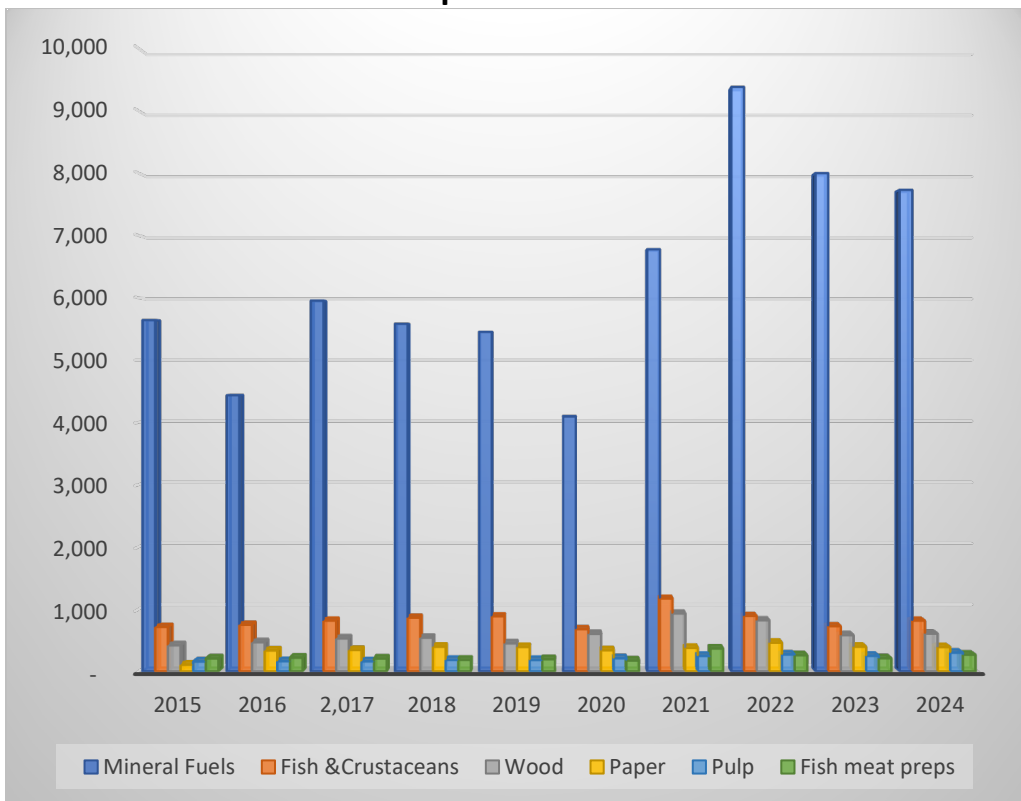
5. Major Commodities of NB - US Trade: Imports (US\$M)



Top N. B. imports from the U.S. are mineral fuels, seafood, computers and vehicles.

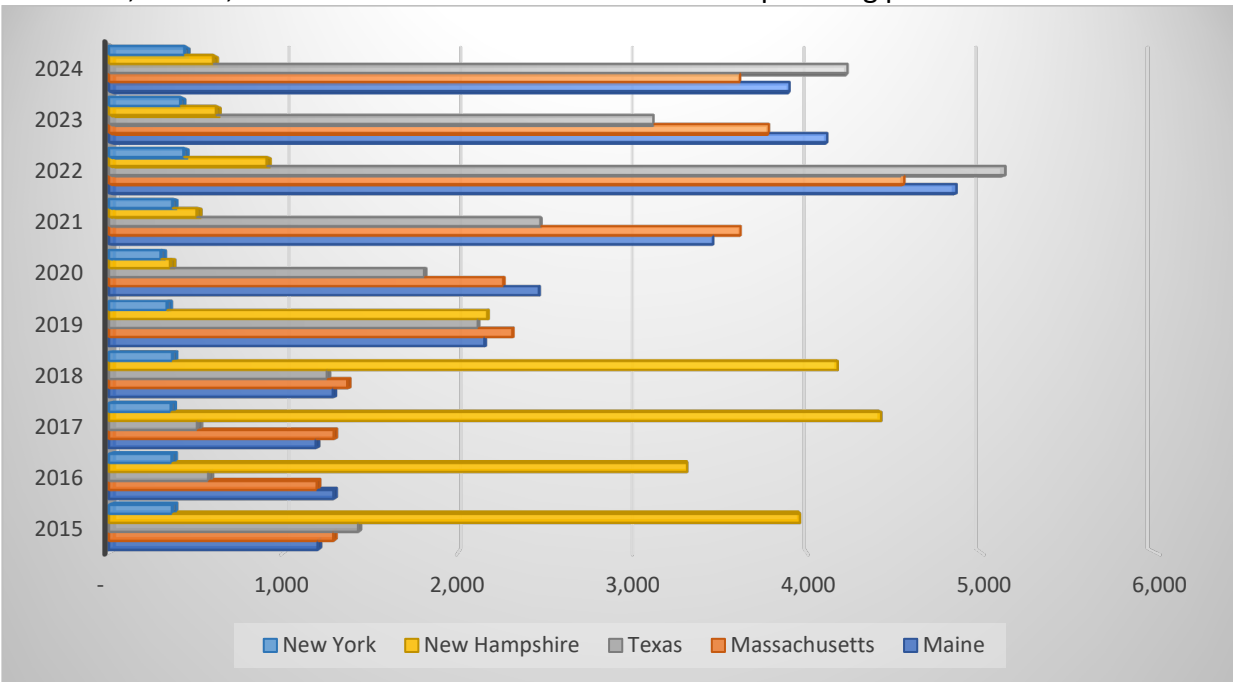
6. Major Commodities of NB US Trade: Exports

N.B. exports to the U.S. are mineral fuels, fish and crustaceans wood, pulp and paper.



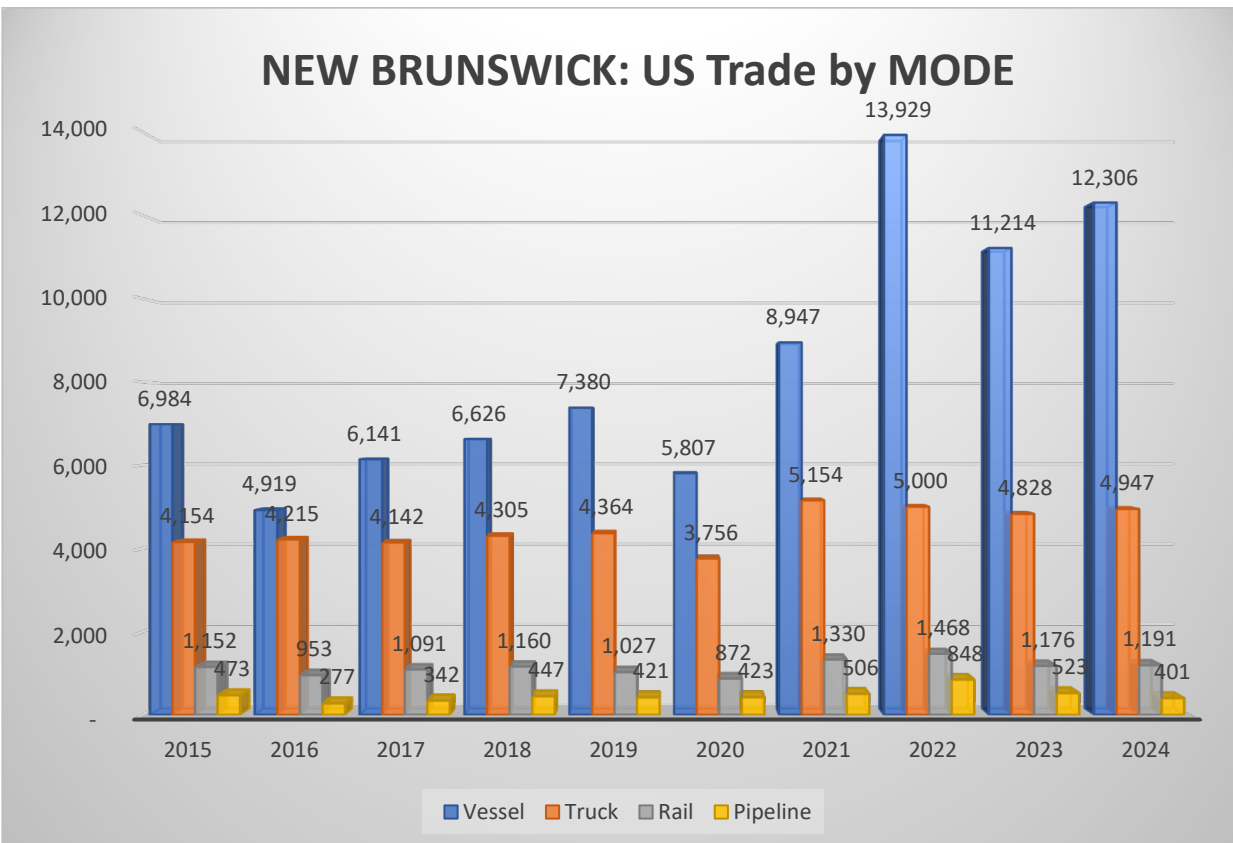
7. TOP U.S. TRADING PARTNERS: New Brunswick and States

Since 2020, Maine, Massachusetts and Texas were N.B.'s top trading partners.

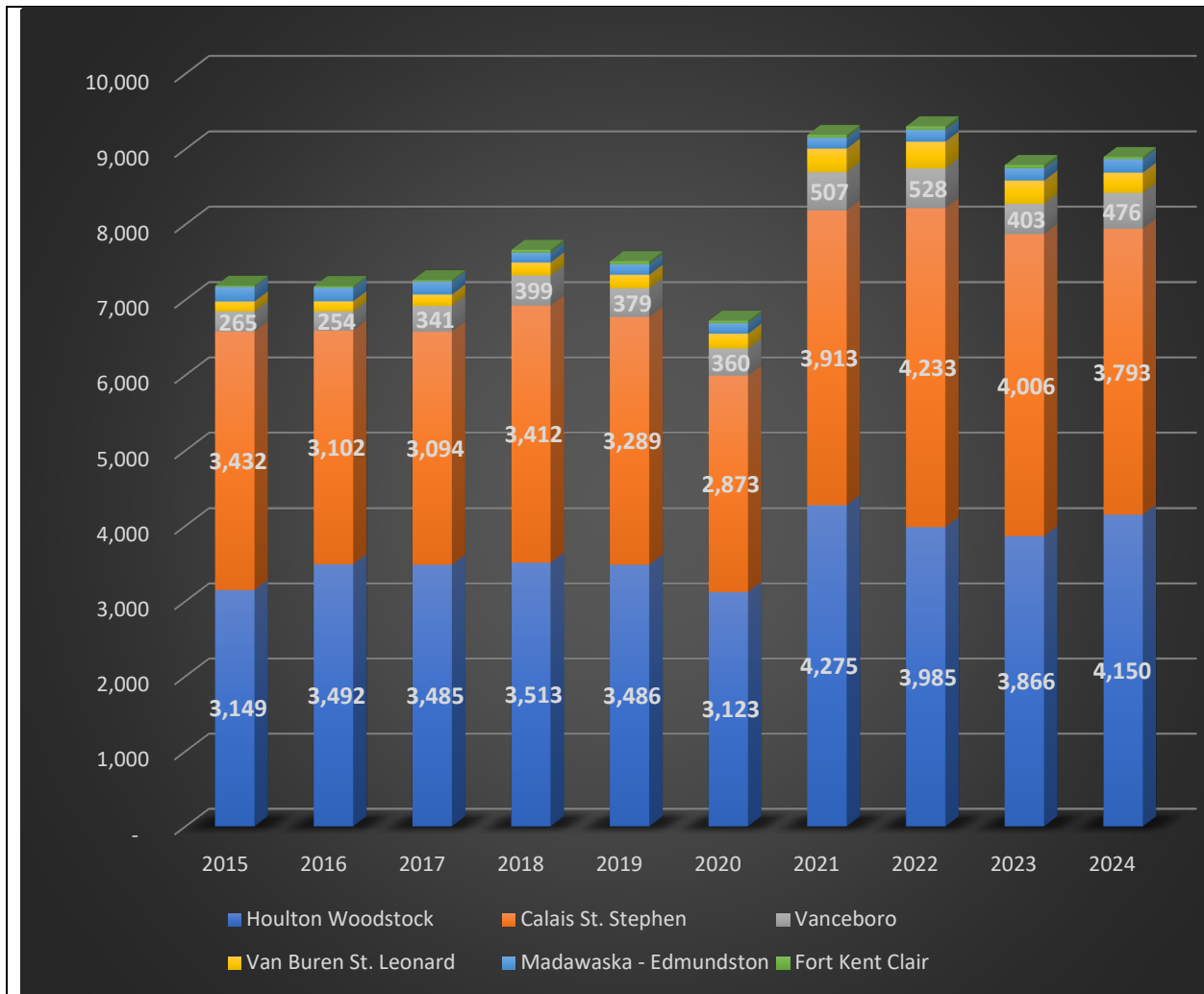


8. TOP Shipment Modes of N.B. – U.S. TRADE (US\$M)

In 2024, 65% of NB – US total trade was transported by vessel. Trucks are second at about 26%.
