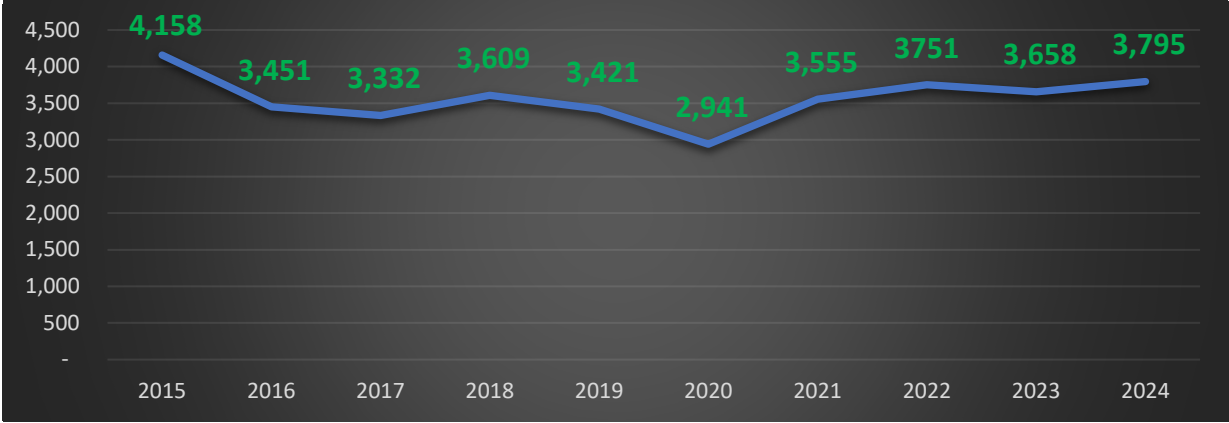


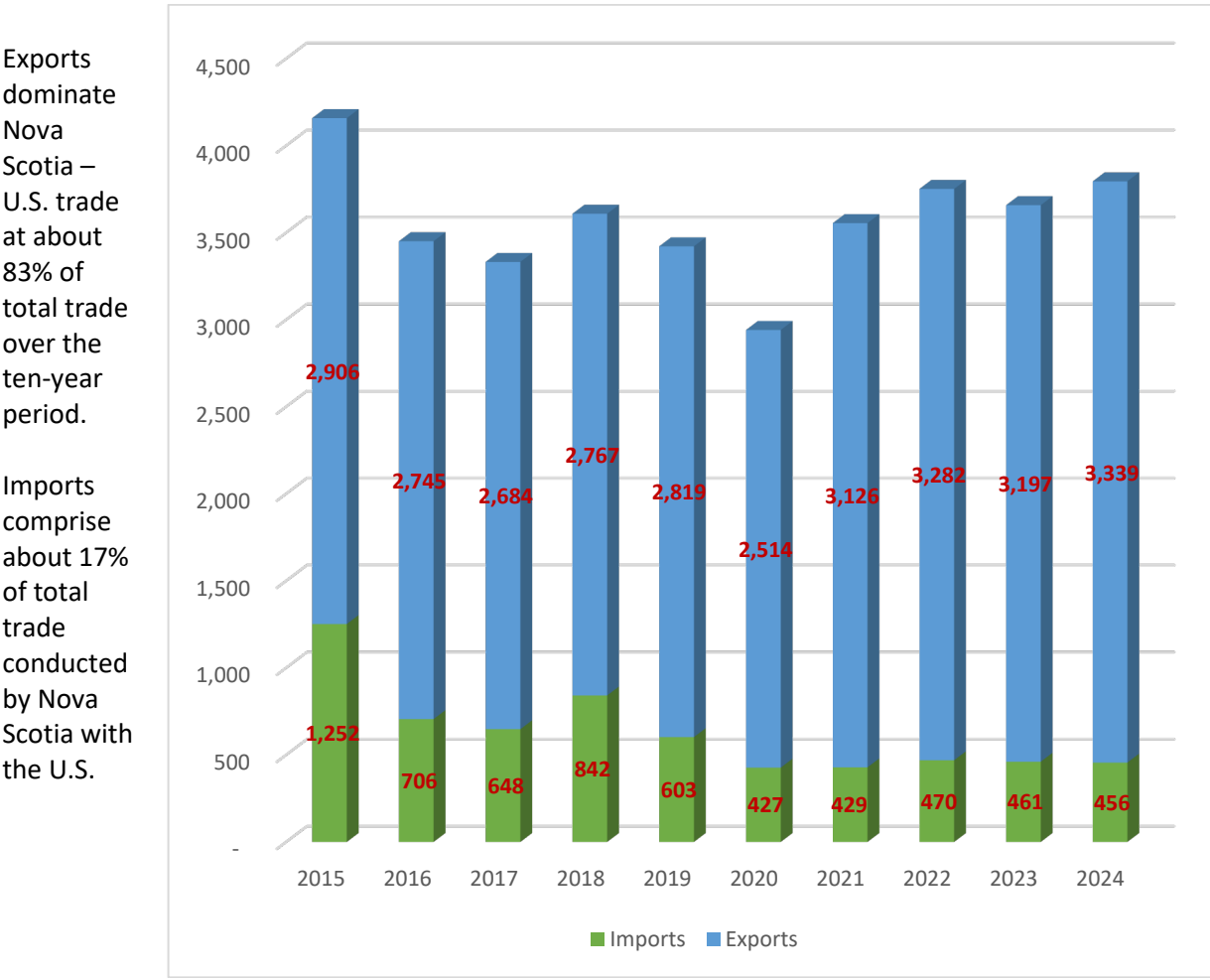
NOVA SCOTIA: CANADA – U.S. TRADE

1. Total Nova Scotia – US Trade – Exports and Imports (US \$M)

Total NS - US trade decreased by \$137 Million from \$3.7 billion in 2023, to \$3.8 billion in 2024. This was comprised of a \$142 million increase in exports and a \$5 million decrease in imports.



2. Nova Scotia – Share of Exports / Imports U.S. – Nova Scotia Trade



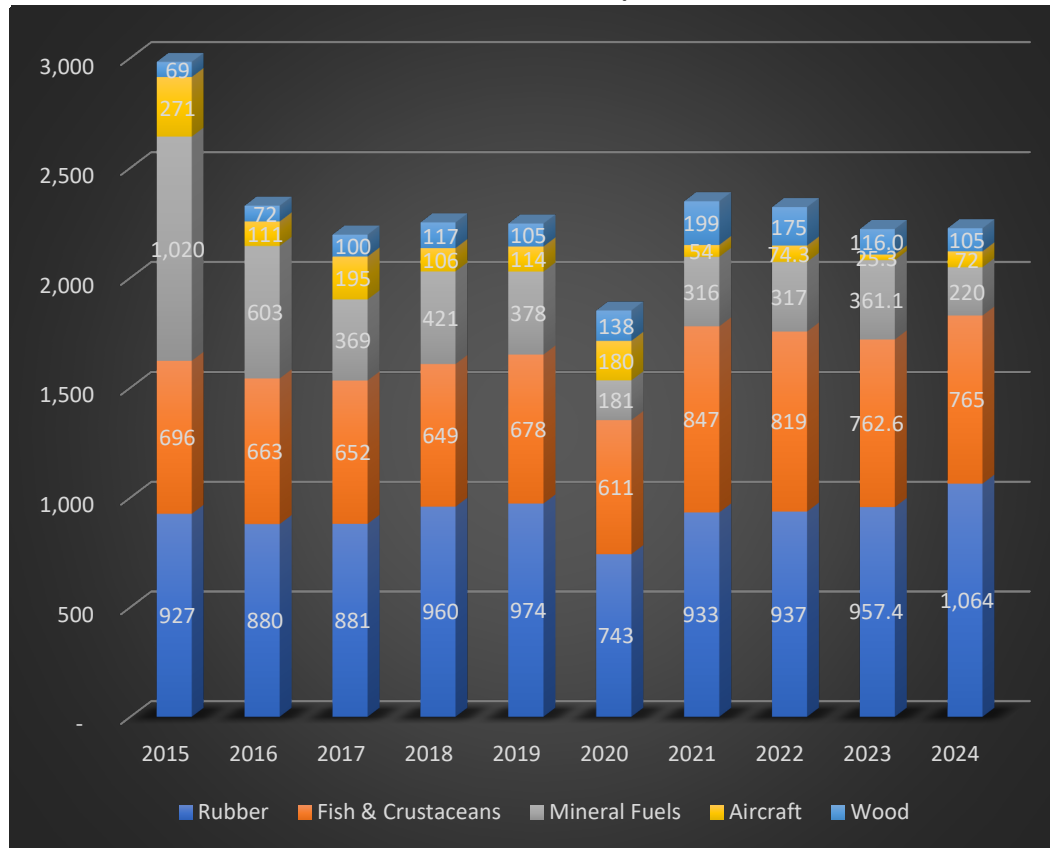
Exports dominate Nova Scotia – U.S. trade at about 83% of total trade over the ten-year period.

Imports comprise about 17% of total trade conducted by Nova Scotia with the U.S.

3. Major Commodities of N.S. – U.S. Trade: Total US\$M

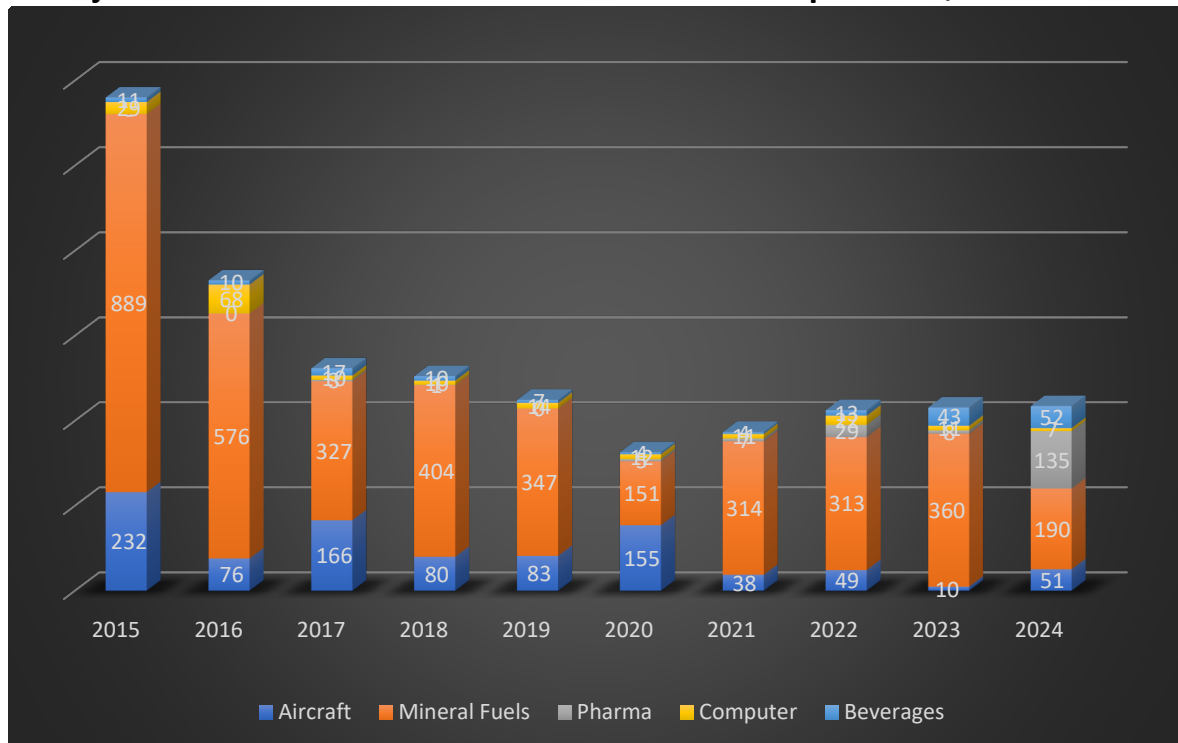
Over half, (54%) of total Nova Scotia – U.S. trade in the ten - year period is from the top three commodities

1. Rubber
2. Seafood
3. Mineral fuels.



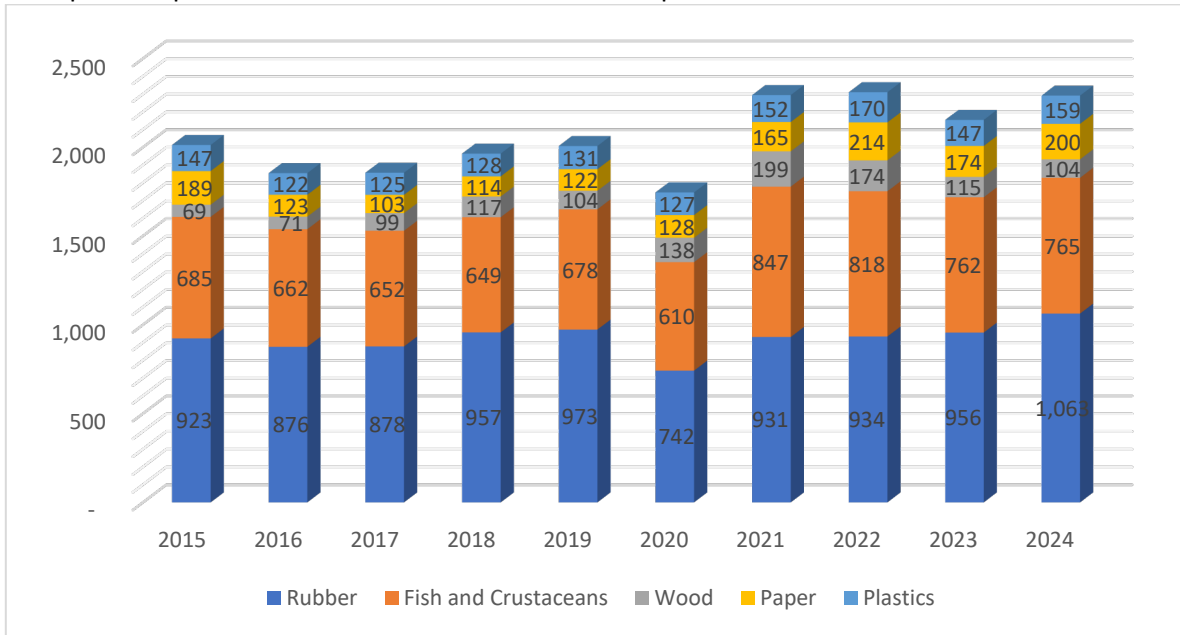
4. Major Commodities of Nova Scotia - US Trade: Imports US\$M

Top N. S. imports: aircraft, and mineral fuels.

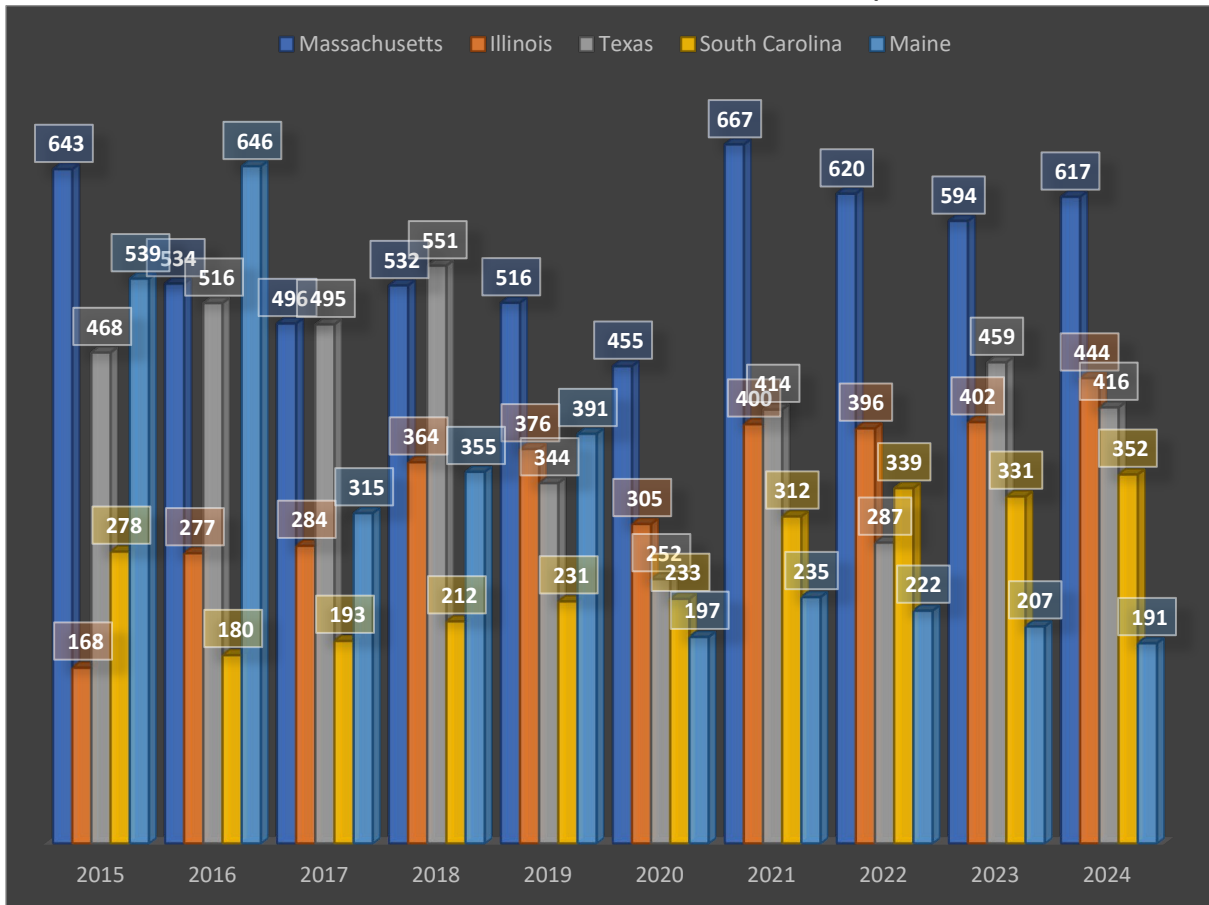


5. Major Commodities of Nova Scotia – U.S. Trade: Exports US\$M

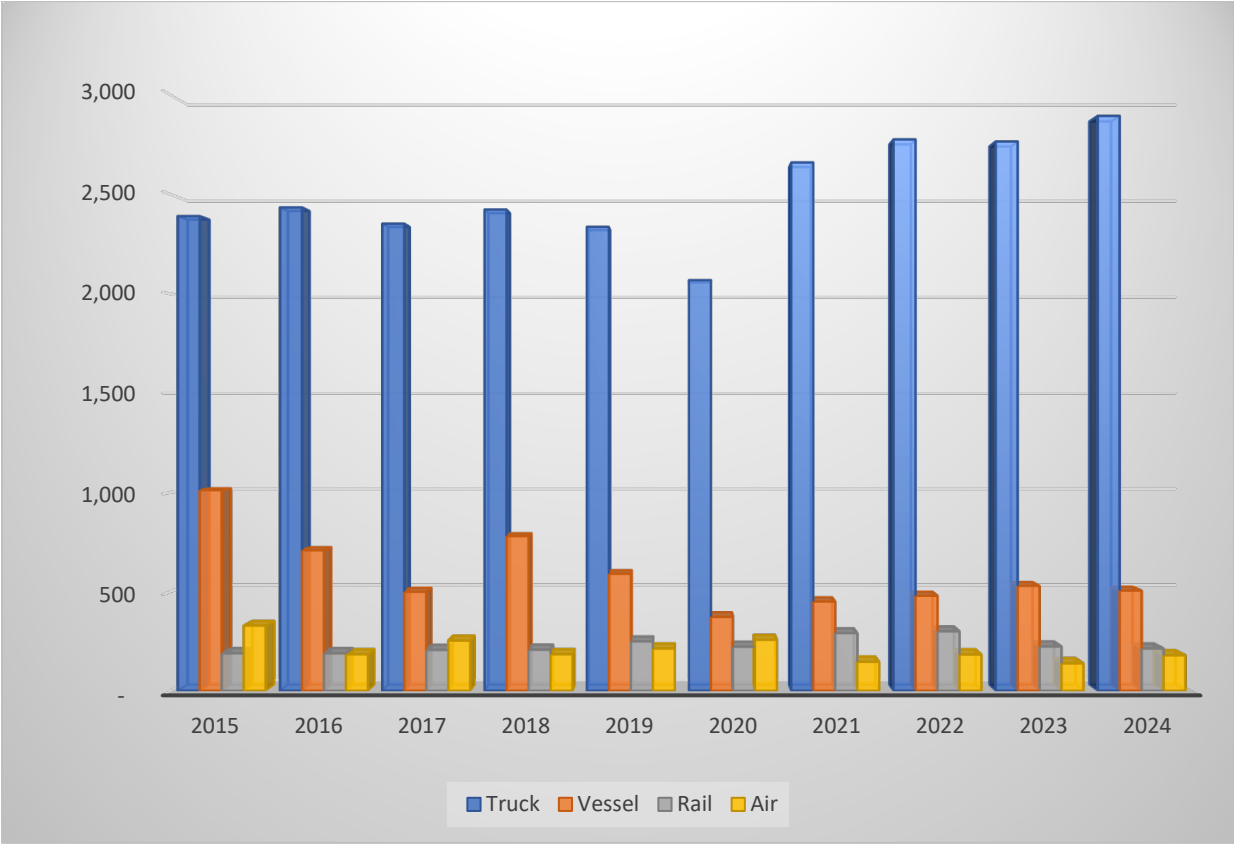
Top N.S. exports to the U.S. are rubber and seafood products.
